What we are doing

Construction of the realigned Manor Drive continues to complete the surfacing, reinstate the footway and kerb remedial works.

What to expect

Tuesday 26 May to Friday 10 July 2026.

Traffic will be diverted onto the newly aligned section of Manor Drive with a lane closure in place for the duration of the extended work duration.

The lane closure will be in place 24/7. Our working hours will be from 7am to 8pm each weekday and Saturday's from 7am to 4pm. In addition, there will be two full 24/7 periods when our team will be working continuously.

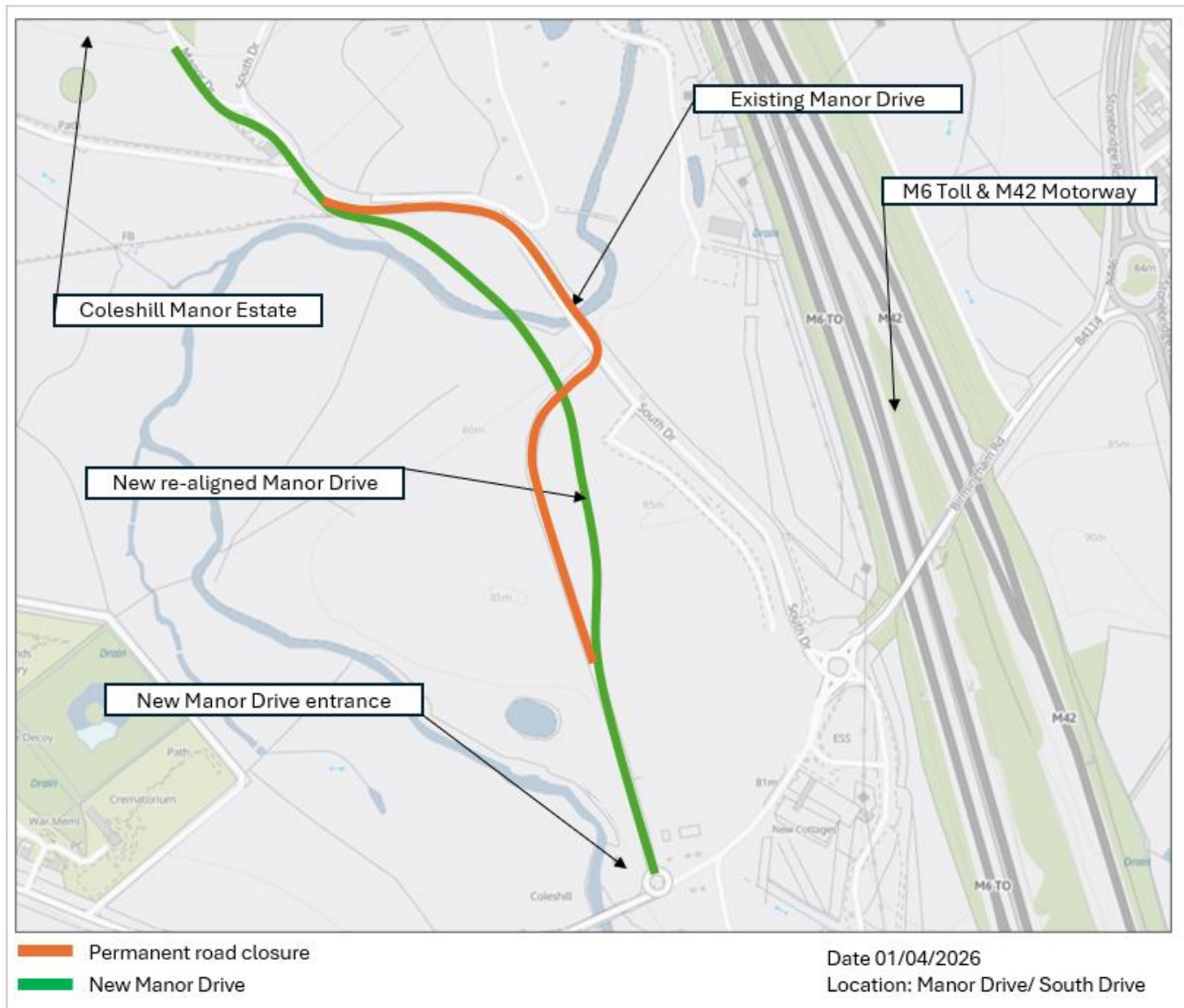
