### What we are doing

A series of works at the station. Some of these works will need to run outside normal working hours to enable the next phase of construction.

### What to expect

**Haul Road:** Construction of a new site road by excavating the ground, installing drainage, and pouring concrete.

**Piling related works:** Removal of sheet piles.

**Tent removal:** Removing a temporary equipment storage area .

## Haul Road Works

Following our previous notice: Old Oak Common: Haul Road Works (ref: HS2-OOC - SCP-26-2090), Working hours will be extended to weekends during the day. However all noisy works will be during core working hours (Monday – Friday, 8am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm). Works will only take place on a handful of weekends as a contingency with most works being completed by late August.

## Piling removal works

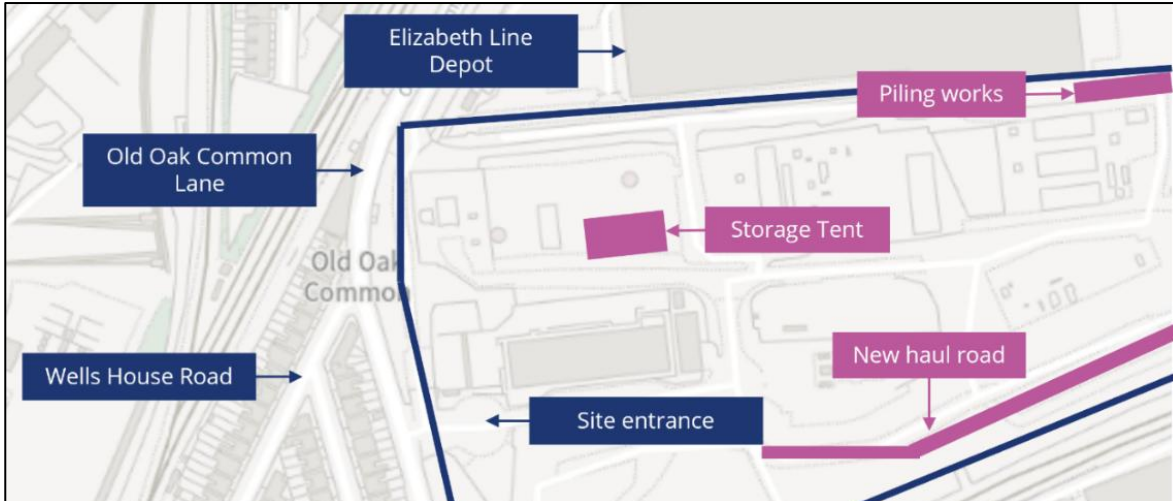
Works by the Elizabeth Line depot take place within restricted hours, so we will have to start one-hour earlier and finish one-hour later (7am – 7pm) Wednesday 3, Thursday 4, and Friday 5 June, in order to deliver the works on time. The works consist of removing sheet piles so we are able to install utilities in the future. The works should not be disruptive, as we will be using silent press removal methods.

## Tent Removal

Before we are able to hand over part of our works area to our HS2 partners at SCSJV, we need to remove a large tent used by our subcontractors to store materials. The works are planned to be completed during normal hours, however we have a contingency to continue works on Saturday 6 June and Sunday 7 June (8am – 6pm). The works should not create excessive noise.

## Additional information

We will mitigate noise impacts as best as possible, including the use of acoustic blankets and shrouds, and stopping works when noise exceeds acceptable levels. Our teams will be briefed on being quiet and respectful of the local community, especially outside of normal working hours.
