Lanes 2 and 3 will be closed in both directions, lane 1 will remain fully operational.

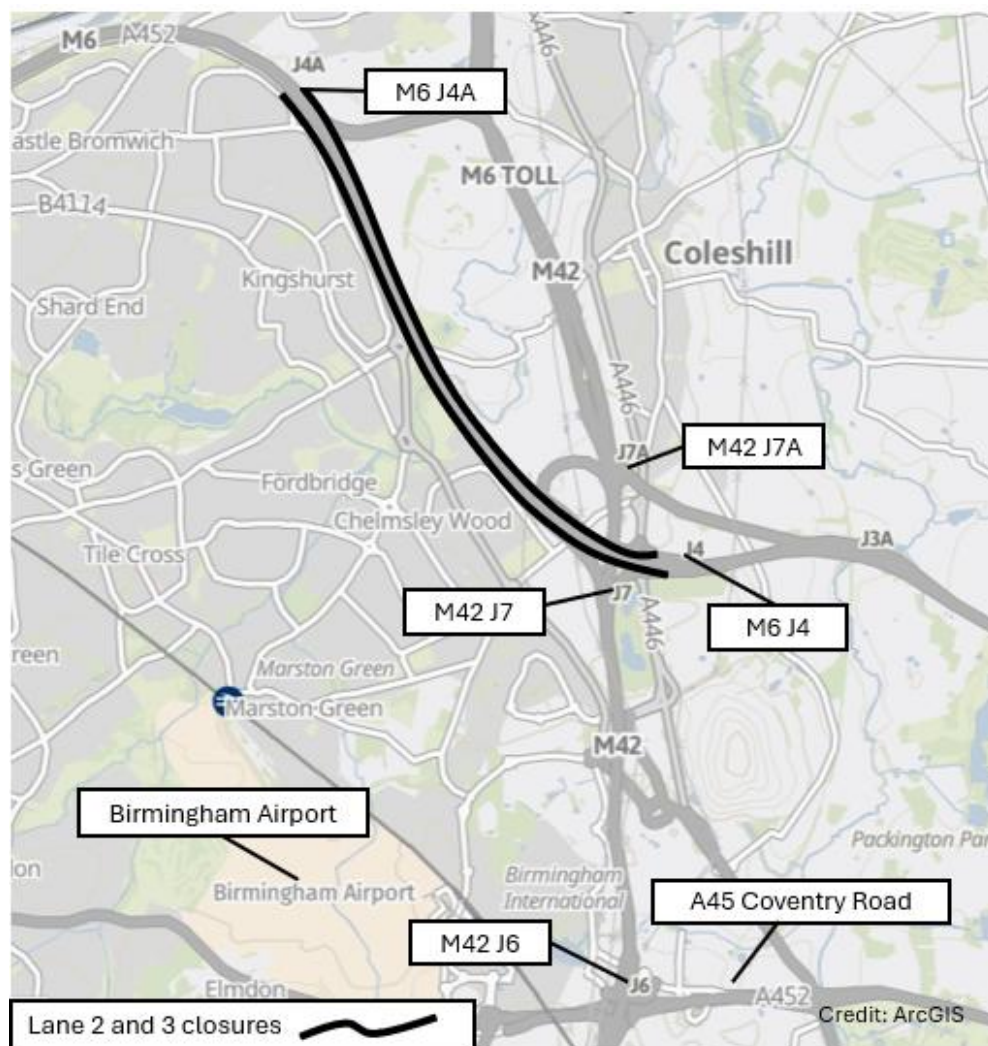
