We are reinstating two lampposts which were temporarily removed during our utility works in the area.

Lane and footpath closure on College Crescent. Pedestrian diversion in place. This work may be noisy. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible.

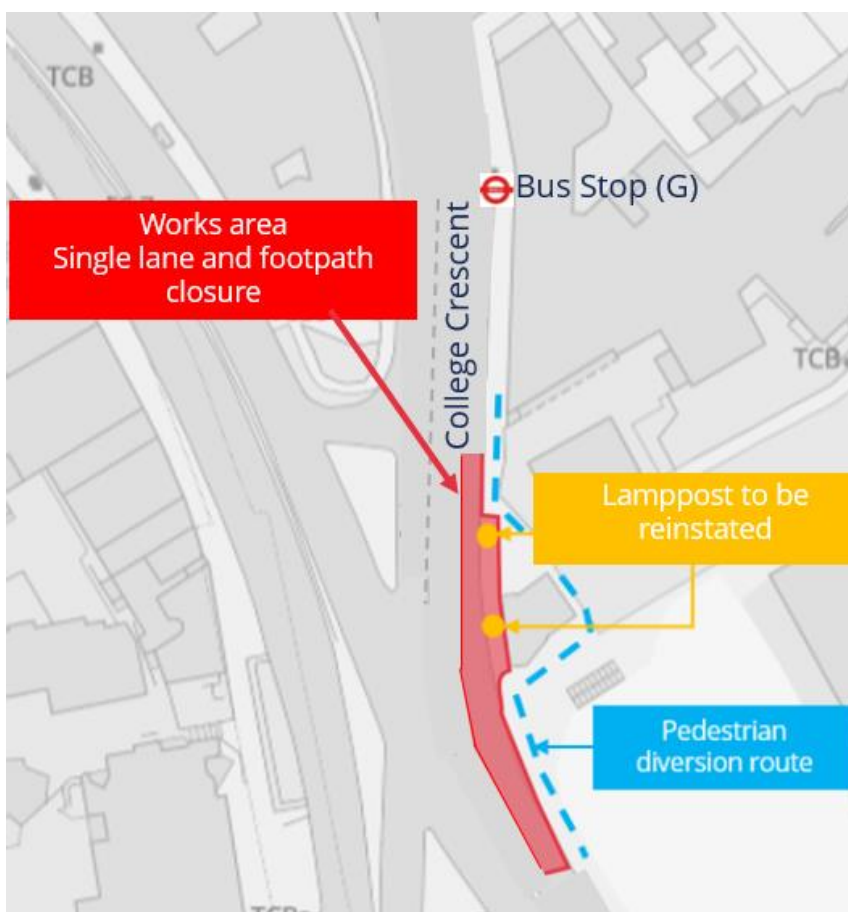
On 26 and 27 June 2026, we will excavate the two locations on the footpath where the lampposts will be reinstated.
