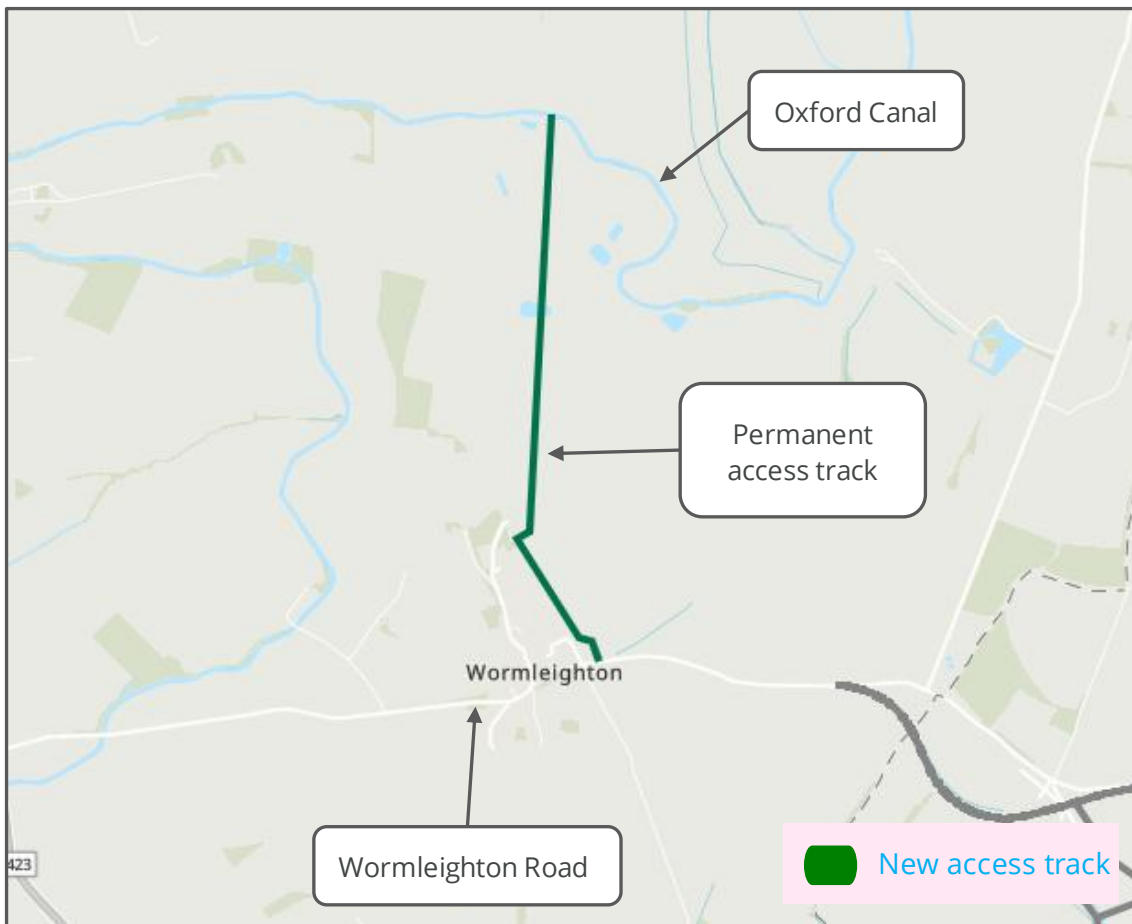
Additional information:

The first 20-metres connecting to the public highway off Wormleighton Road will be tarmac and gated. The remaining track will consist of a rolled stone surface.

The track will be used to access the viaduct for future inspections and maintenance avoiding HS2 traffic travelling through Wormleighton. The new track is in the same location as the previous track and will continue to be used by the local farmers.
