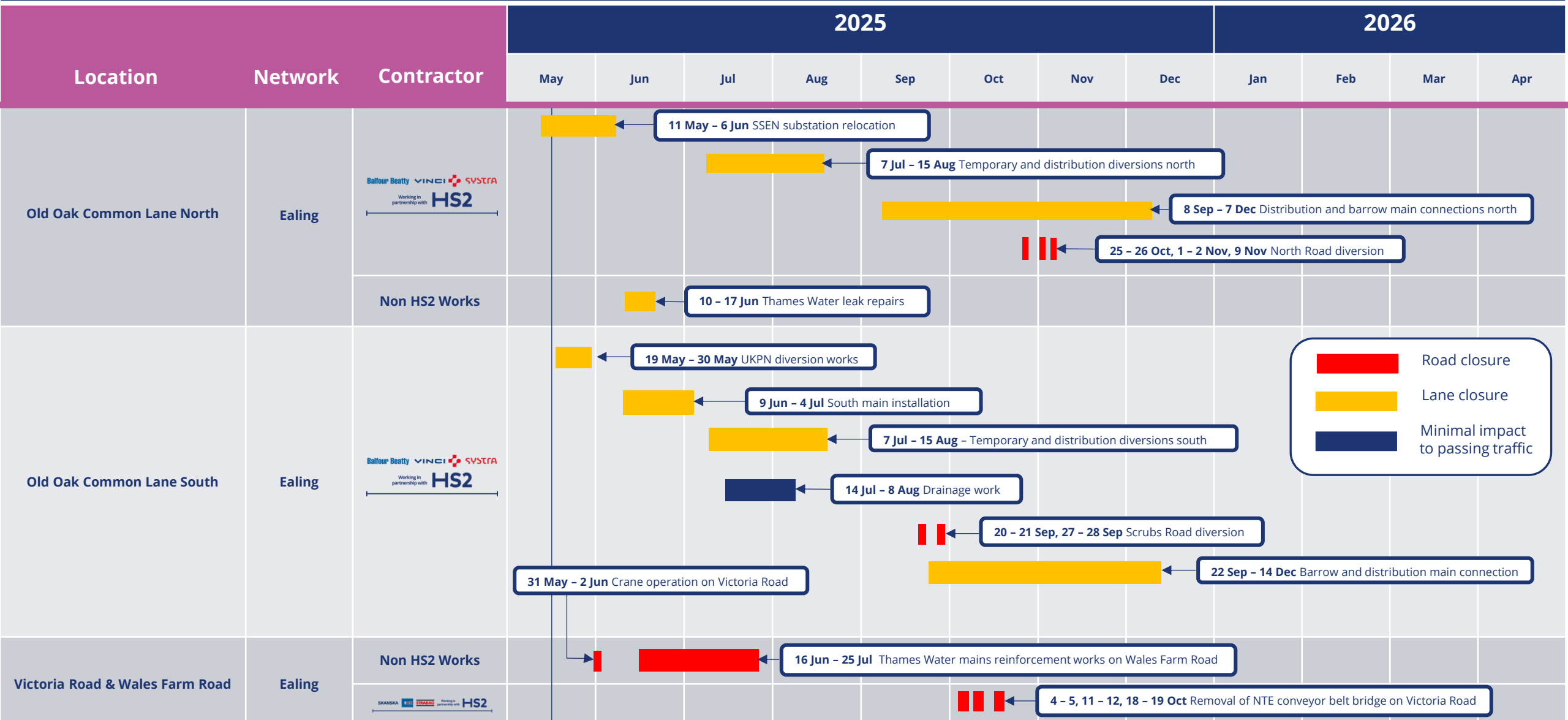

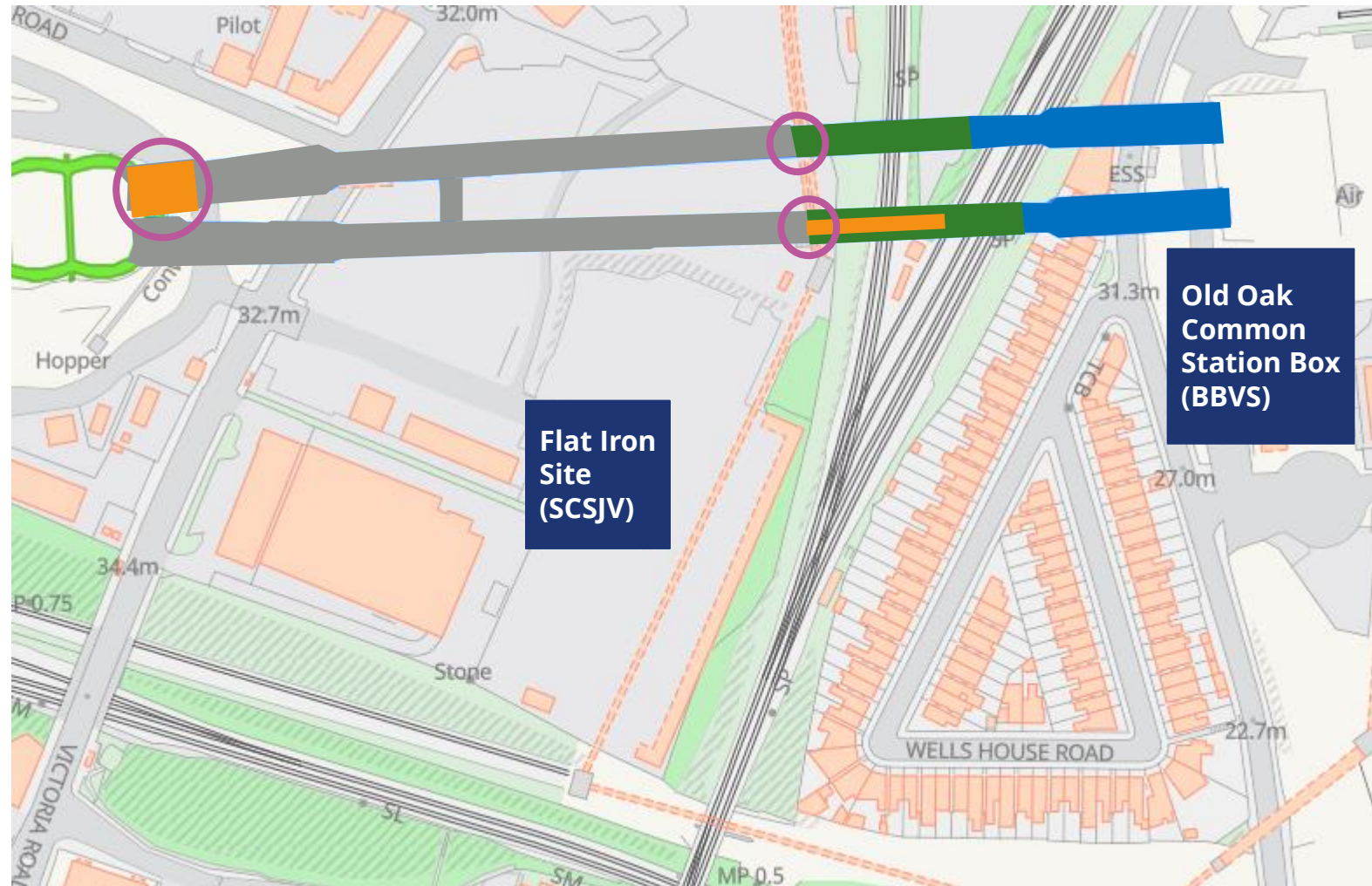
## Breaking out hours

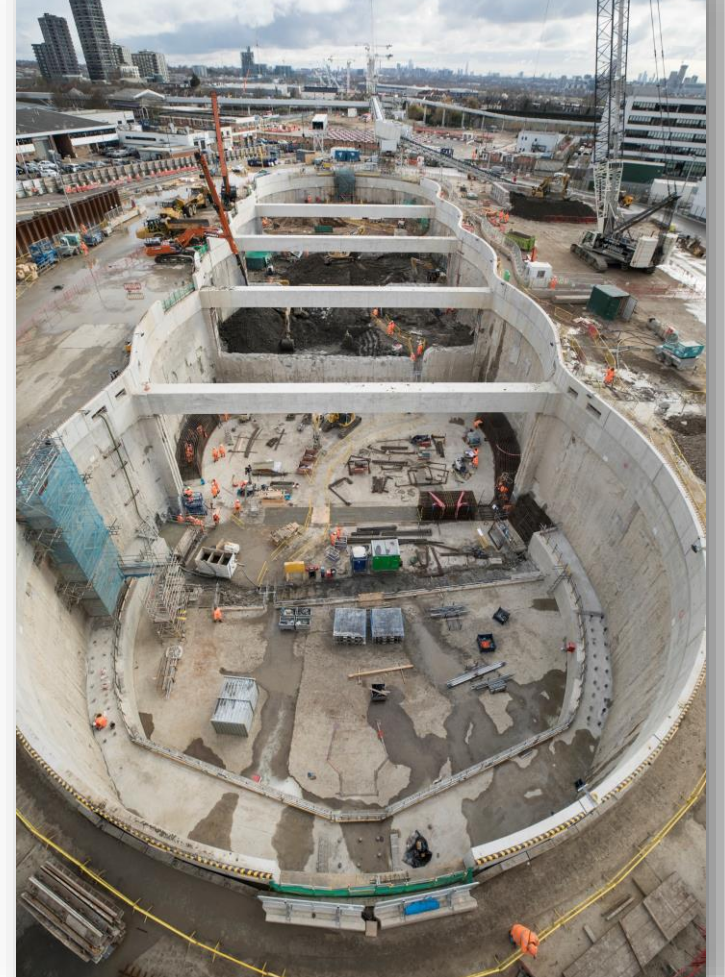

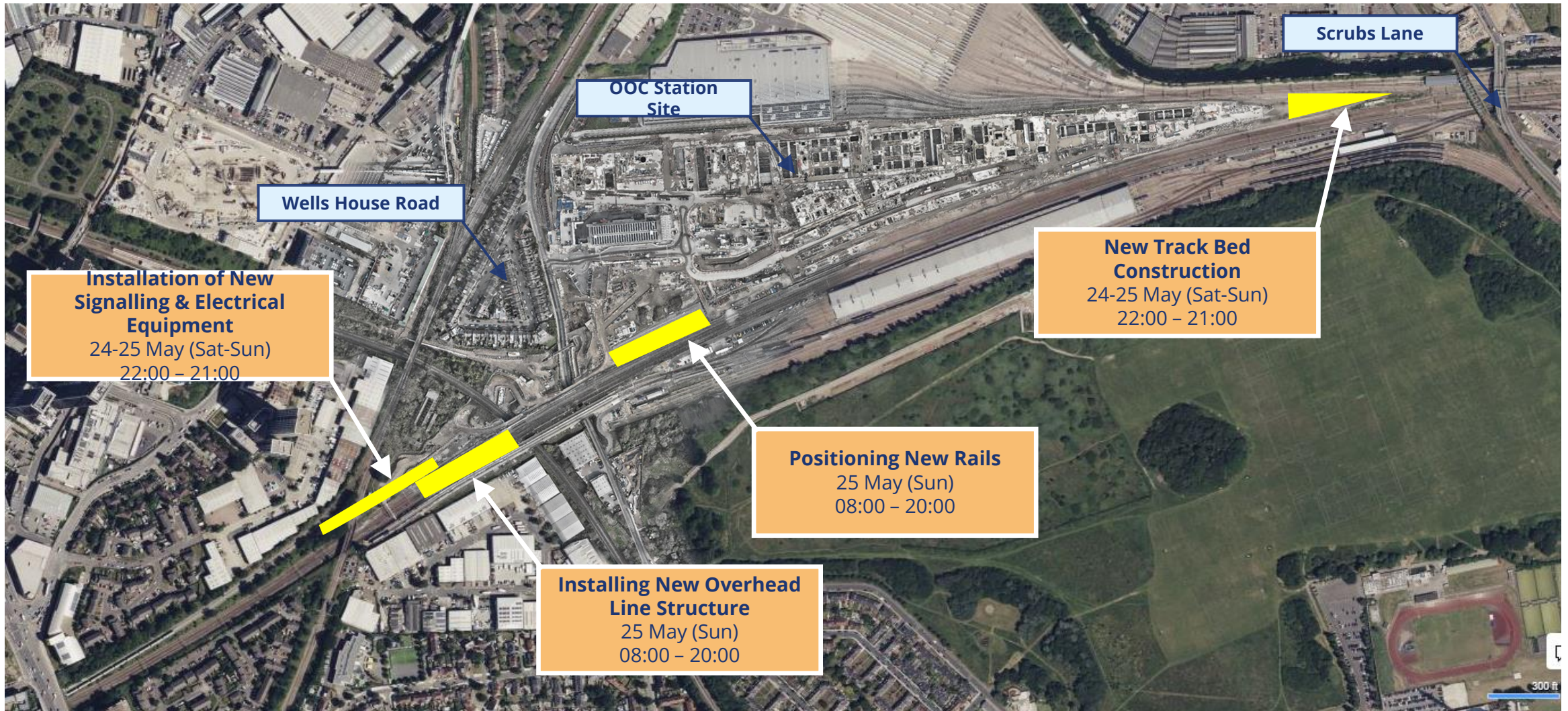

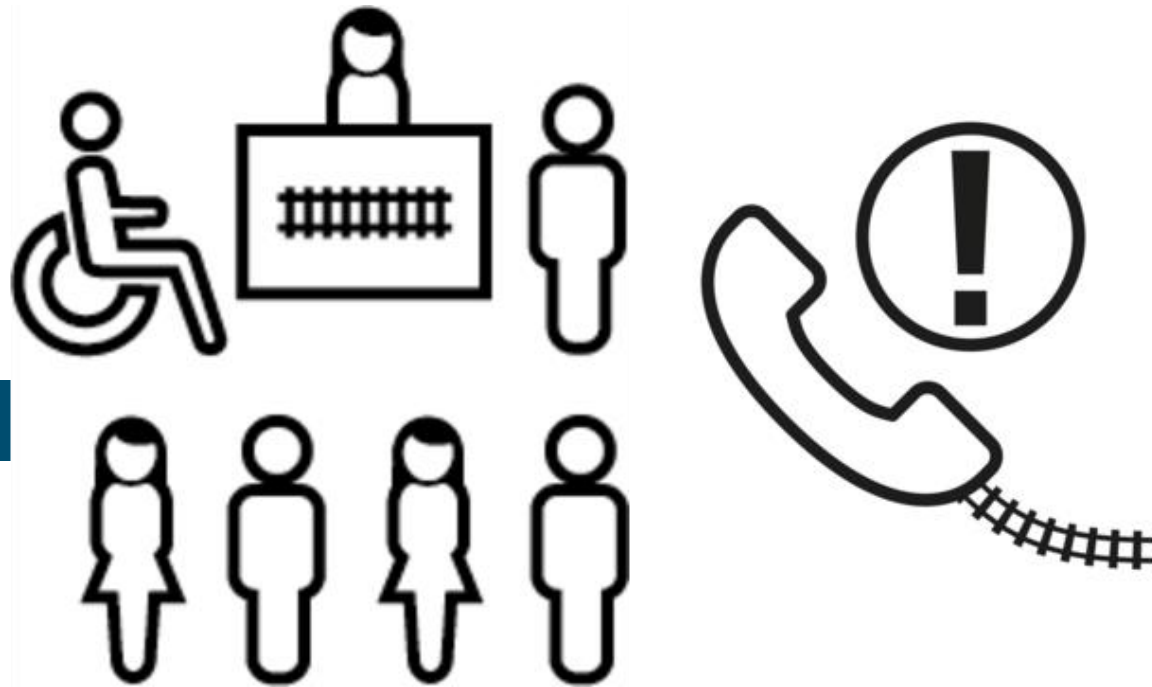
