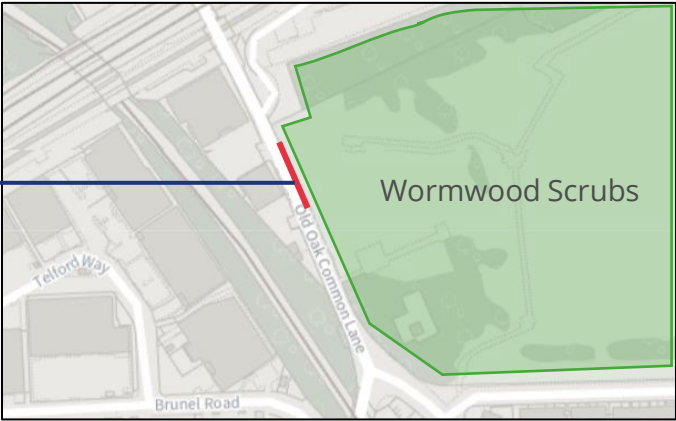

Old Oak Common Lane realignment

- Old Oak Common Lane will be realigned from September 2025 so work around the utility connections can take place.
- For the southern realignment, road closures will be on:
 - Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 August*
 - Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 September (contingency weekend)
- The community have been invited to a drop-in at Old Oak Common Station site on Wednesday 23 July, 5-7.30pm.

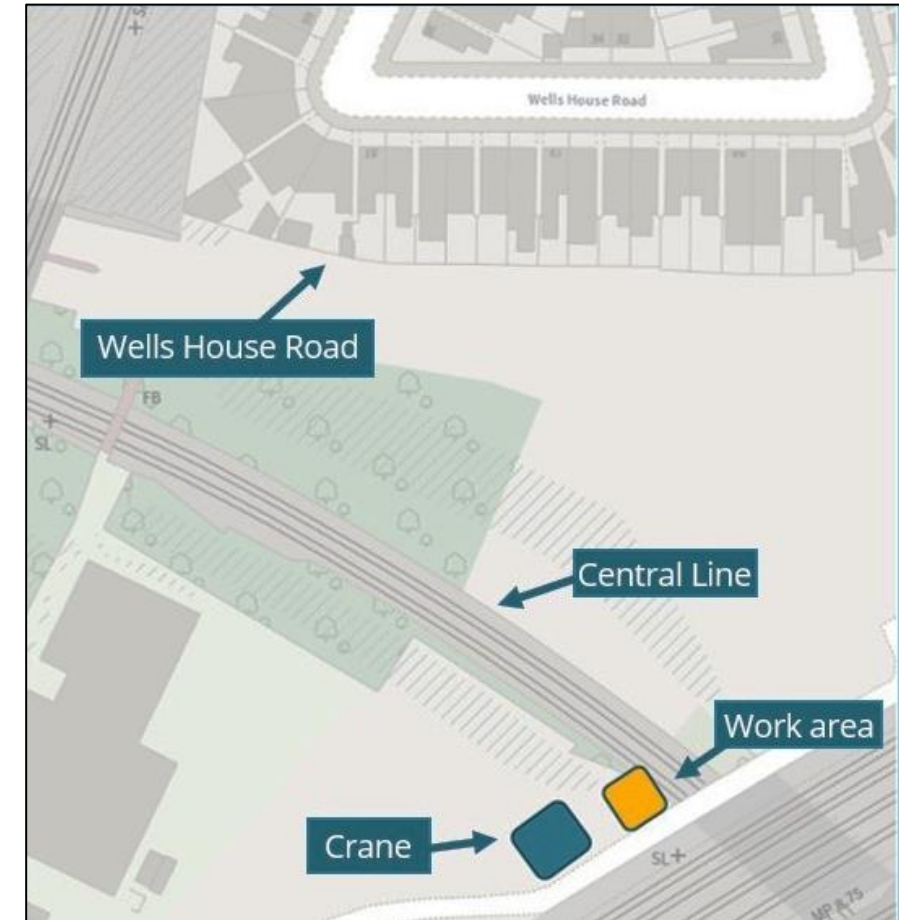
Old Oak Common Lane site entrance works

- Since Monday 30 June, we have been completing utility works, which sit under our site entrance. This is likely to be completed by Wednesday 23 July.
- These utilities provide services, such as gas and water, that need to be diverted. This is also in preparation for the tunnelling into Old Oak Common Station.
- Work involved breaking concrete, excavating trenches, laying pipes, re-filling the trenches and then relaying the road surface.
- Due to our mitigation activity, we only received one complaint during this period.



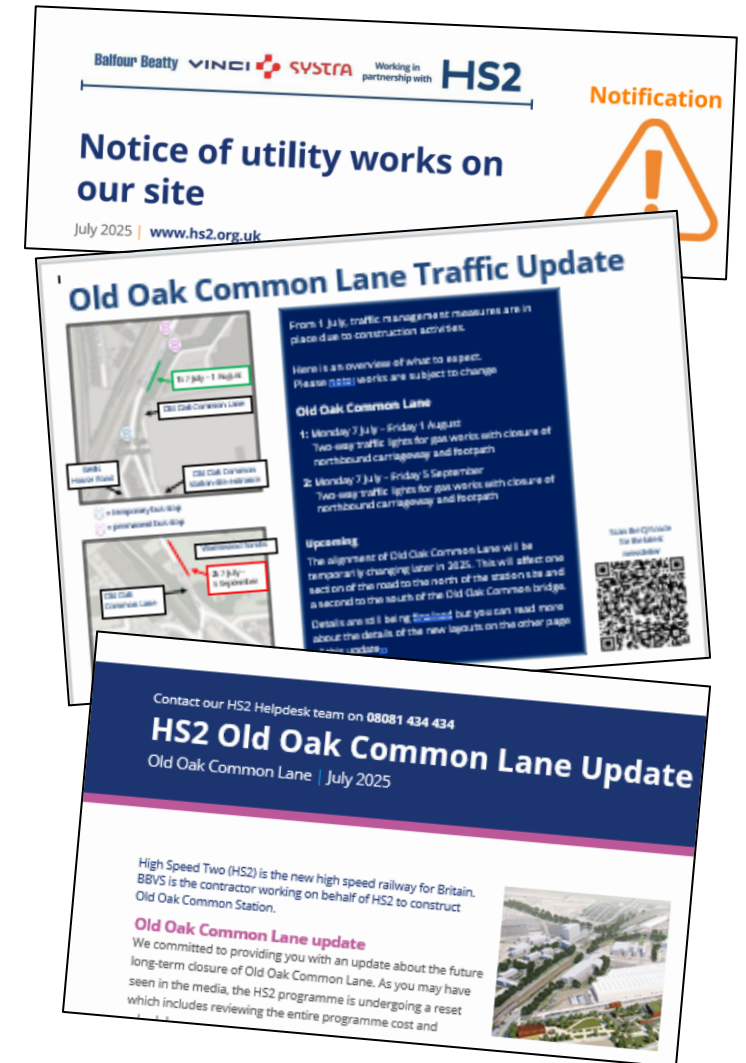
Central Line piling works

- A continuation of construction works near to the Central Line is needed to support the infrastructure for the expansion of the Network Rail railway and for new railway bridges.
- The metal sheet piles will be pushed into the ground, not hammered.
- These will take two weeks to complete later this year, and dates are yet to be confirmed.

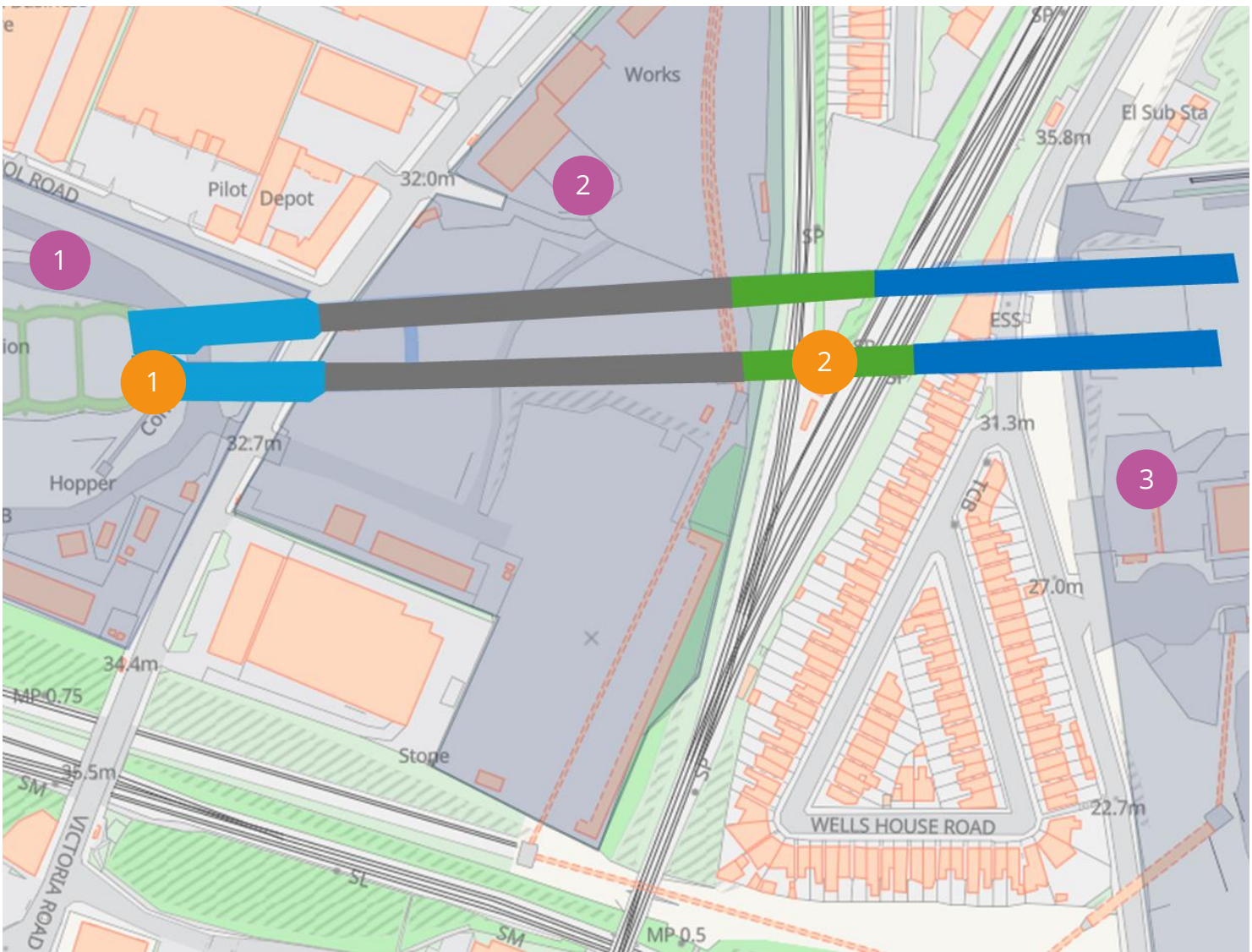


SCS Updates – site and tunnels

Old Oak Common Tunnel



- 1 Victoria Road Crossover Box (SCSJV)
- 2 Flat Iron site (SCSJV)

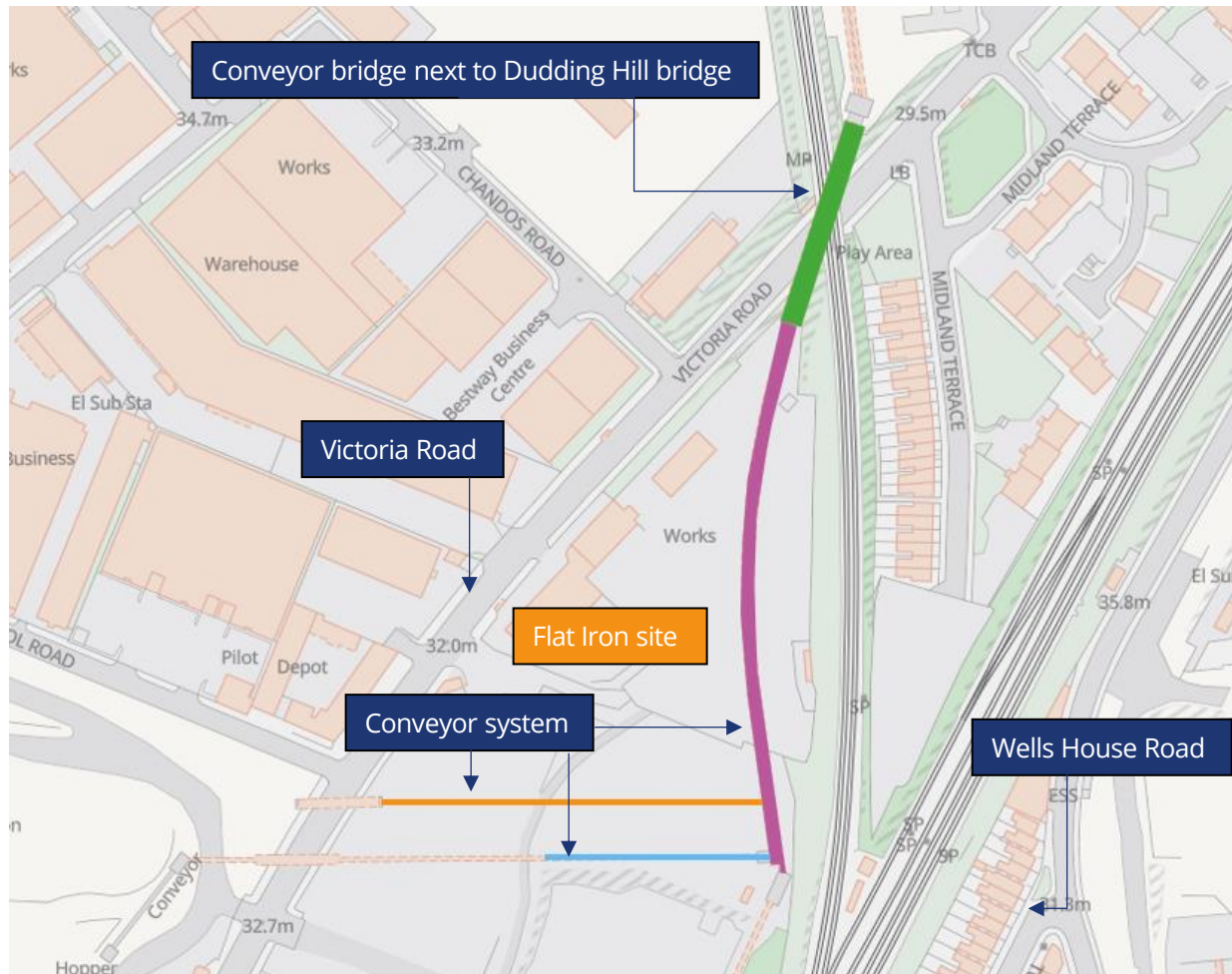

Depth: Approximately 14m below ground level (Old Oak Common Lane)

Length: Total length of tunnel is 360m

Conveyor removal – Flat Iron site

From **2 August 2025 to 1 November 2025**, we will be working 24 hours a day, seven days a week to remove sections of the conveyor in the Flat Iron site and on Victoria Road next to Dudding Hill bridge.



Sections of conveyor - removal dates

Blue – Downline Conveyor: **2 August – 1 November 2025**

Orange – Upline Conveyor: **2 August – 1 November 2025**

Purple – Overhead Conveyor: **2 August – 1 November 2025**

Green – Conveyor Bridges: **4 October – 20 October 2025**
(further details about this work will follow in September 2025)

How we will remove the conveyor

We will disconnect the conveyor from its supports using a crane. Once this is done the conveyor will be lifted to ground level and taken apart within the site.

Noisier works will be carried out during the day and where possible, noise barriers will be in use.

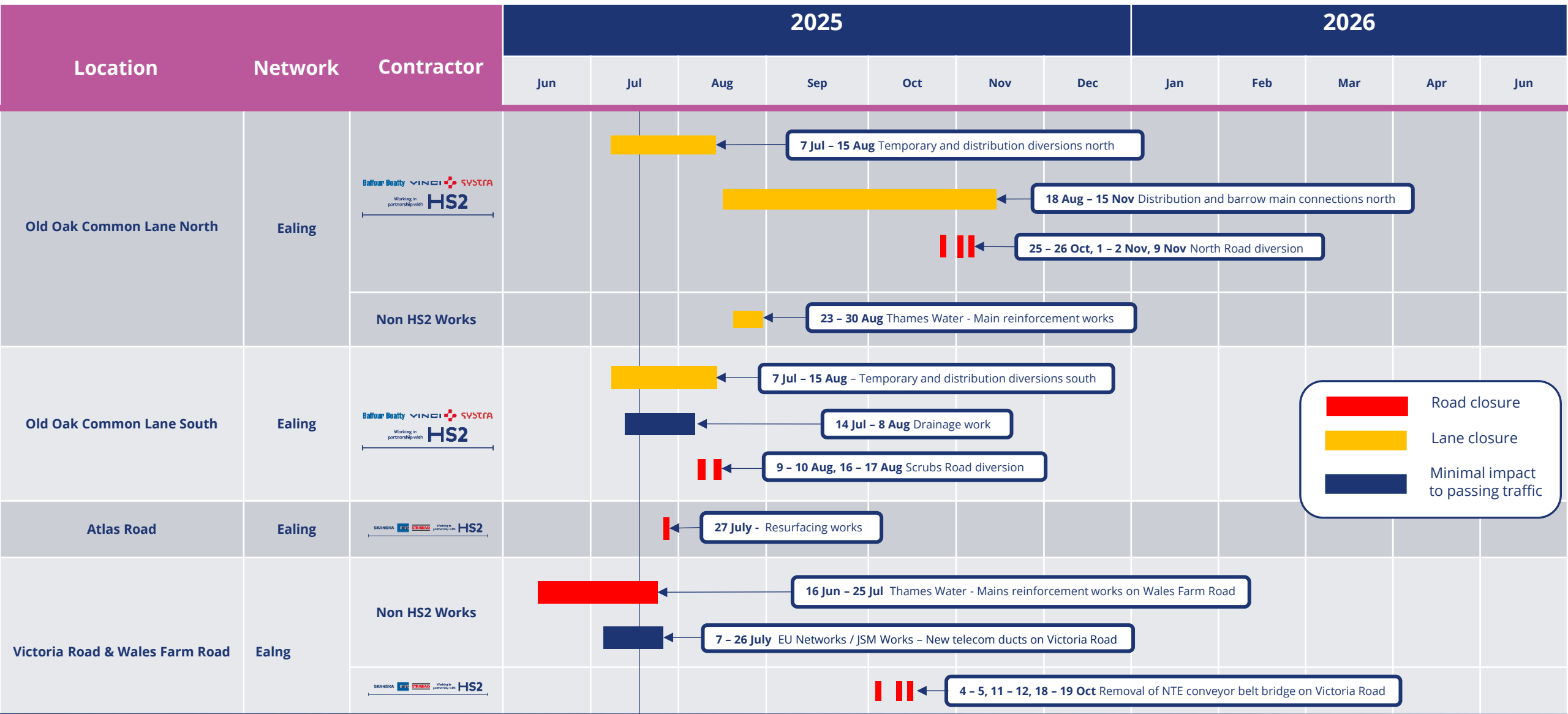
