

Update - Notice of Waddesdon Greenway closure & overnight works

Location

Waddesdon Greenway, Fleet Marston.

Duration

26 Days – Monday 10 August to Friday 4 September.

What we are doing

We are completing the realignment of Waddesdon Greenway (FMA/1) bridleway. The new section of the Greenway will cross the HS2 line over a new steel bridge.

What to expect

Full 24-hour closure throughout the 26-day works period. Some overnight working with quieter and busier periods. Our working hours are shown below:

- **Monday to Friday**, 7am to 7pm across the entire works period **and** 7pm to 7am across a total of 11 nights (further details on page 2).
- **Saturday and Sunday**, 7am to 7pm across all weekends that fall within the works period.

Additional Information

Overnight working Monday to Friday - We will carry out the earthworks and drainage installation for the new section of path first, followed by surfacing and finishing works. This will involve the use of heavy machinery.

In order to minimise the duration of the closure, we will be working overnight for **11 nights** during the 26-day works period in addition to daytime working:

- **5 nights** – Monday 10 August to Friday 14 August.
- **3 nights** – Monday 17 August to Friday 21 August (specific 3 nights worked will be progress dependent)
- **3 nights** – Monday 31 August to Wednesday 3 September.

Waddesdon Greenway opening - the new alignment and bridge will be open from 7pm on Friday 4 September providing access for cyclists and pedestrians only. The final bridleway link for horse riders will open from 7pm on Friday 25 September* (see map on last page). This final link will be constructed during core daytime working hours.

*The original opening date for the bridleway link was Tuesday 15 September but has been extended due to weather conditions impacting our program.

Transport arrangements during closure

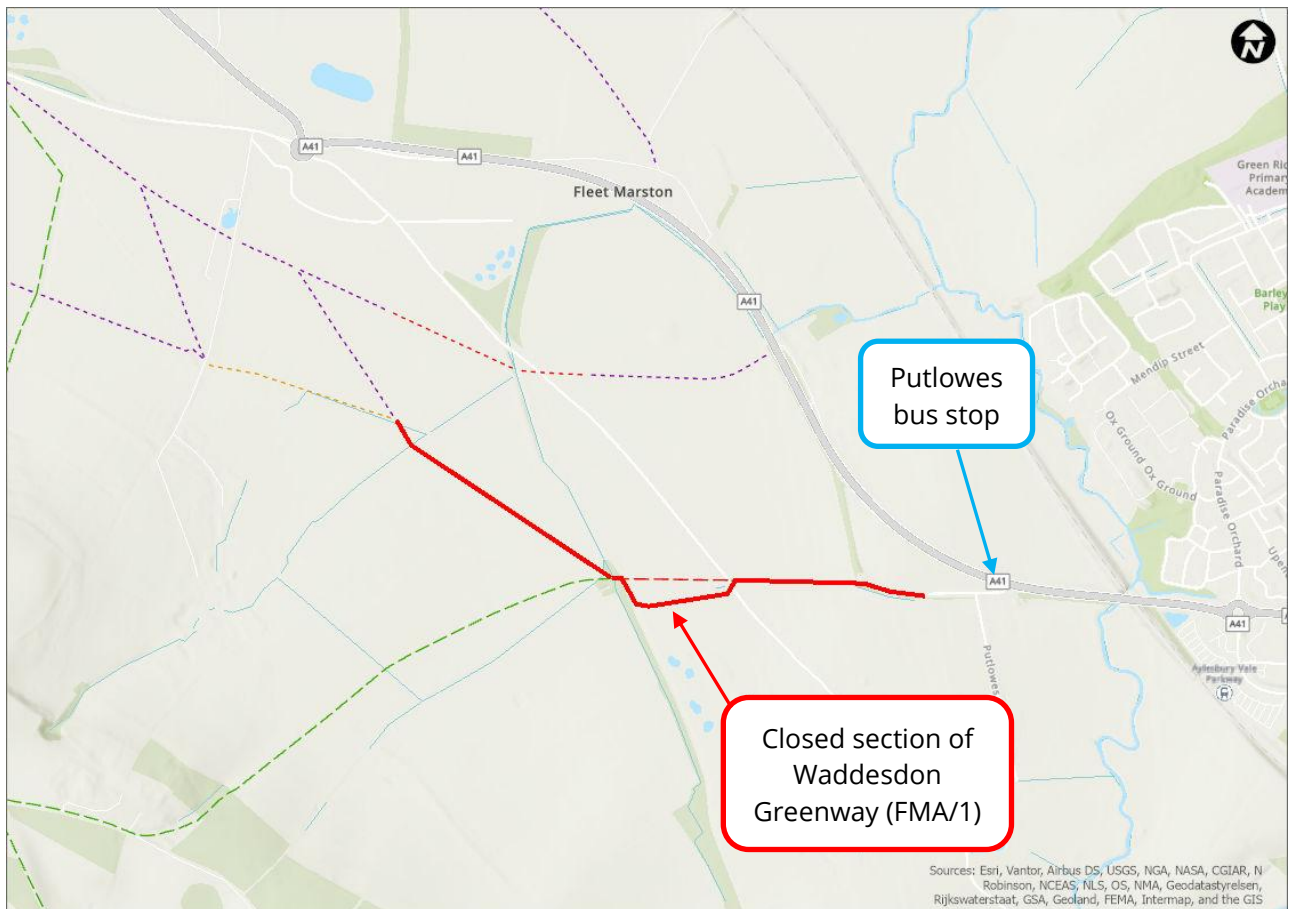
There is no alternative temporary diversion route during the closure. Users of the Waddesdon Greenway will need to find suitable alternative arrangements.

There are regular bus services between Aylesbury and Waddesdon. Between Monday and Saturday, the numbers 16 and 17 Redgroup services between the A41 Putlowes bus stop (indicated on the map on the next page) and Waddesdon. The 616 service also operates during school term time.

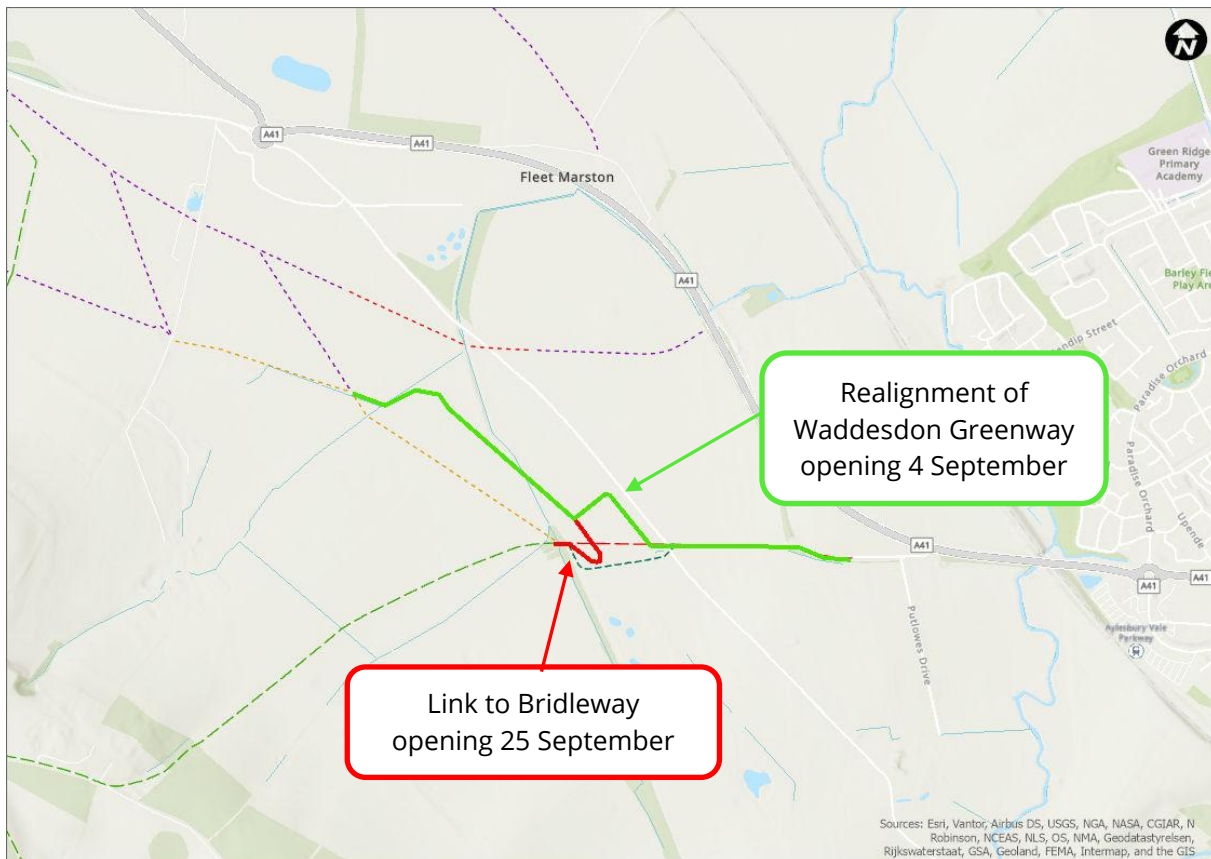
Where we will be working
