

Saturday working: Central Line bridge enabling works

HS2-OOC - SCP-26-2269

Location

Old Oak Common station site (west of Old Oak Common Lane, south of Wells House Road).

Duration

Every Saturday from 18 July until late December, 8am until 6pm.

What we are doing

We are continuing with work to support the construction of railway bridges on land near the Central Line. Residents can expect to experience some construction noise, within the limits allowed by agreement with the local authority.

What to expect

We have to carry out these works on a Saturday to ensure we meet programme dates which impact temporary, scheduled closures of the Great Western Mainline and the Central Line. We will complete our activity as quickly as possible to reduce disruption. We will use equipment and methods which help to reduce noise. We will engage directly with residents impacted by these works. The works are described in more detail overleaf.

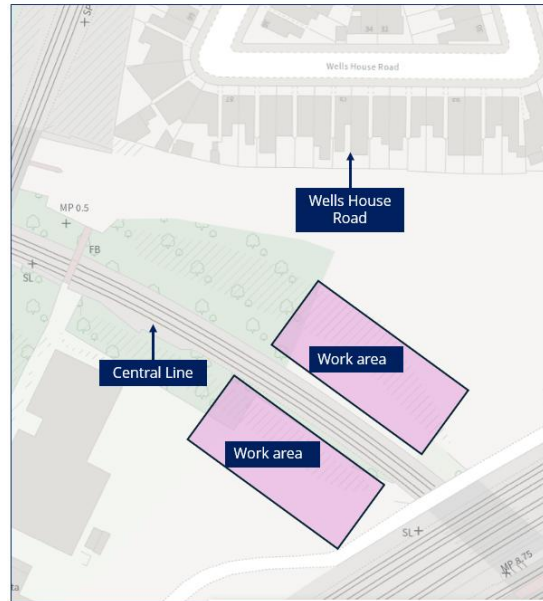

Where we will be working



Central line enabling works

We are continuing with our work to support the construction of railway bridges near the Central Line. Work will take place around 90 metres south from the rear of properties on Wells House Road. We will have some welfare and storage areas north of the Central line tracks too.

This type of work will typically involve piling, pouring concrete, excavating, and fixing steel to form the new bridge structure. We do not anticipate work to be noisy, and we will use all necessary mitigations, including acoustic barriers. Due to the constraints in the area, specifically with the restricted headroom, it will be safer to carry out some activities on Saturdays. We will continue to update this notification with any changes to the plans.
