These works will be between Saturday 1 August 2026 to Monday 3 August 2026 and will require a 24-hour working pattern.

What we are doing

As works are progressing in the area, we will now be pushing the Duddeston Viaduct over the existing Network Rail lines. This is a key part of the route that will carry High Speed trains from the East of Birmingham and into Curzon Street Station, right in the centre of Birmingham.

What to expect

This work will have no highway impacts as it is over the existing Network Rail lines. It will require a 24-hour working pattern so there be some low-level construction noise and lighting overnight.
