What we are doing

We will be cutting back overgrown vegetation, including hedges and weeds. This is to enable the installation of a low voltage cable on Ellesborough Road as part of the reinstatement of the road.

A water pressure test will also be carried out on the existing Ellesborough Road.

What to expect

Day time closure of Ellesborough Road. A diversion route to be signposted.

Some noise from the works is expected.

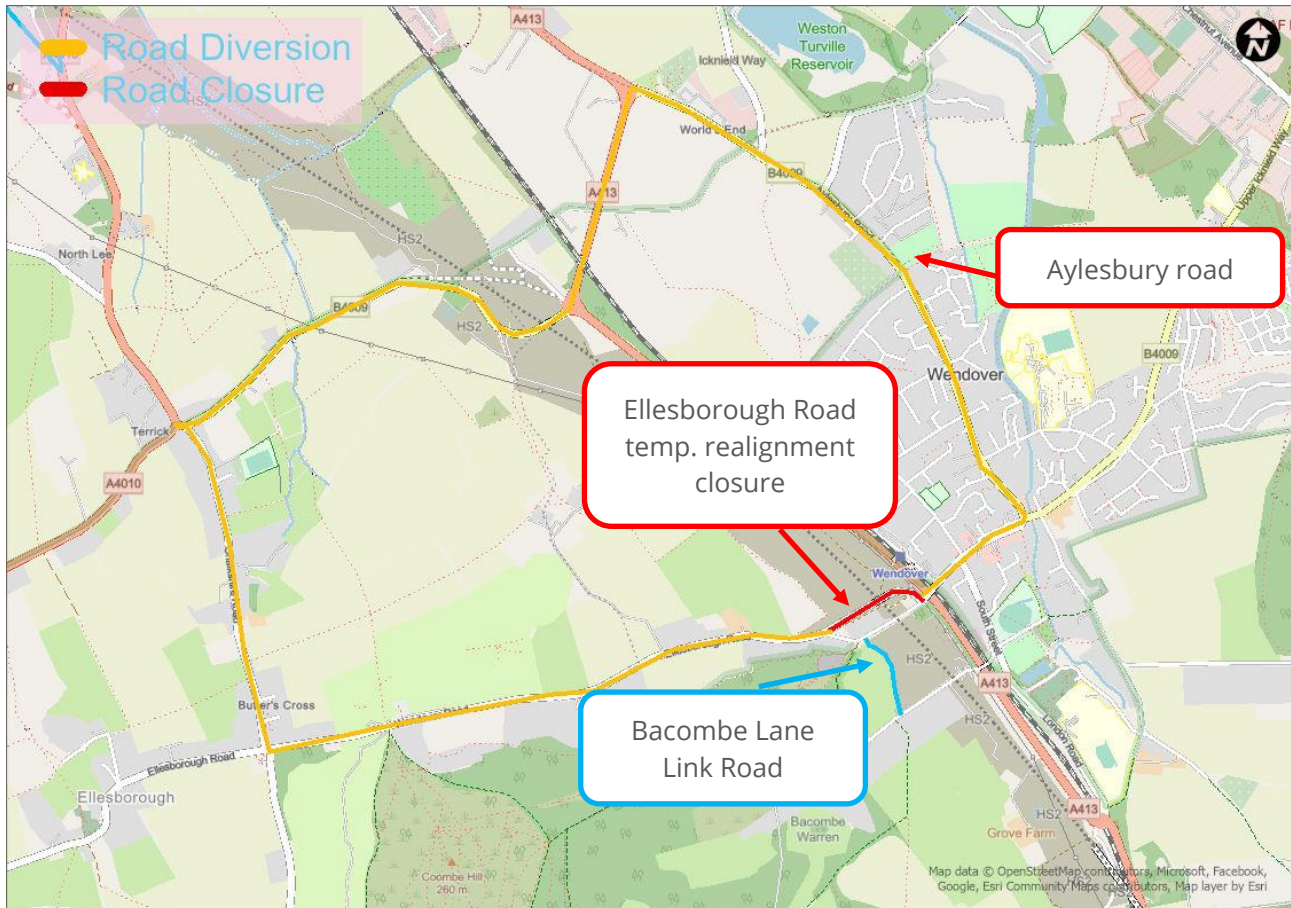
