What we are doing

A lane closure is required to complete works to the V-ditches which run along Station Road north, on the approach to the new road alignment. The works will include stone lining of the ditch, clearance works, and the placement of topsoil in preparation for future planting.

A lane closure managed by two way lights on Station Road north. Access to Melling Farm will be maintained.

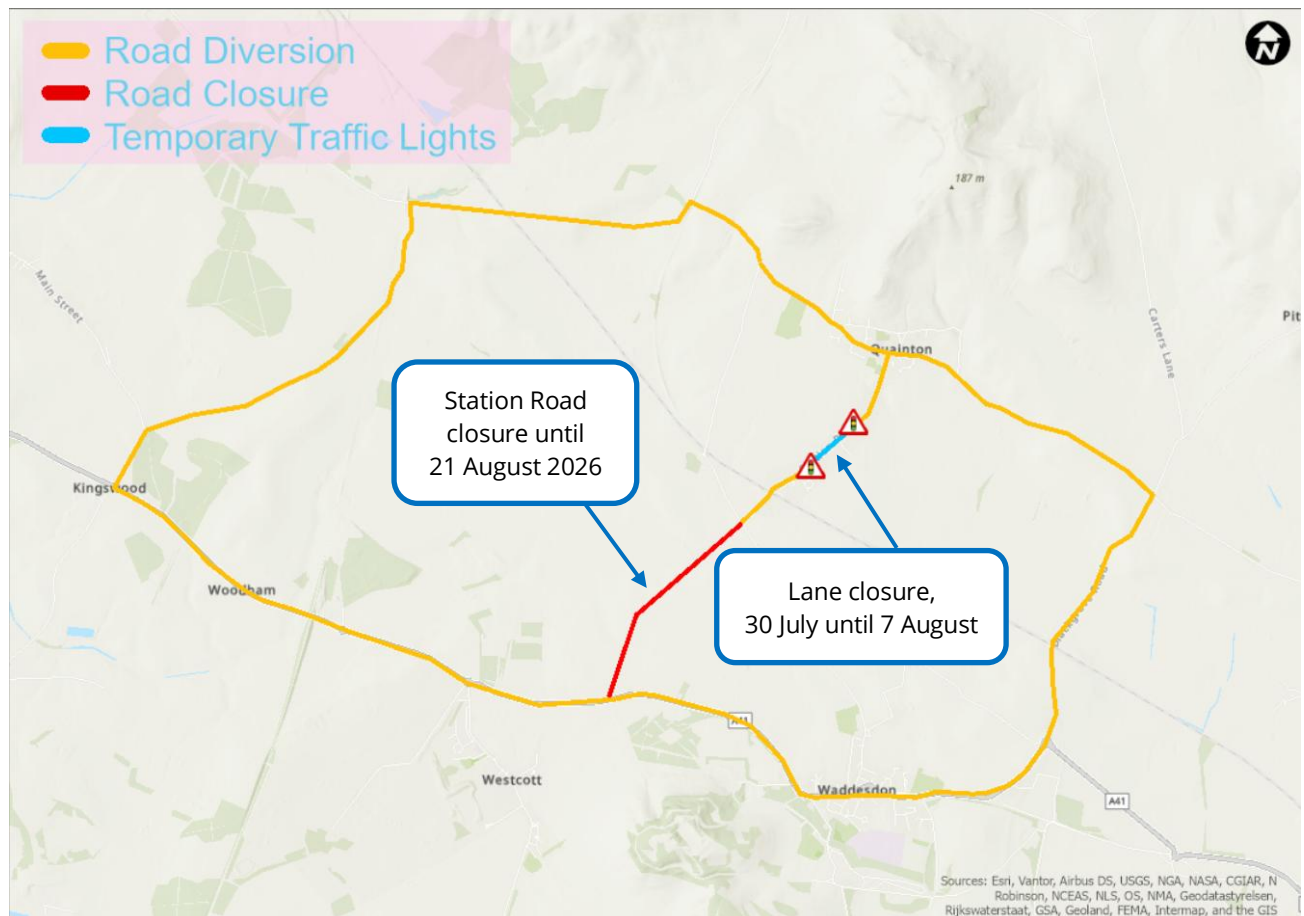
