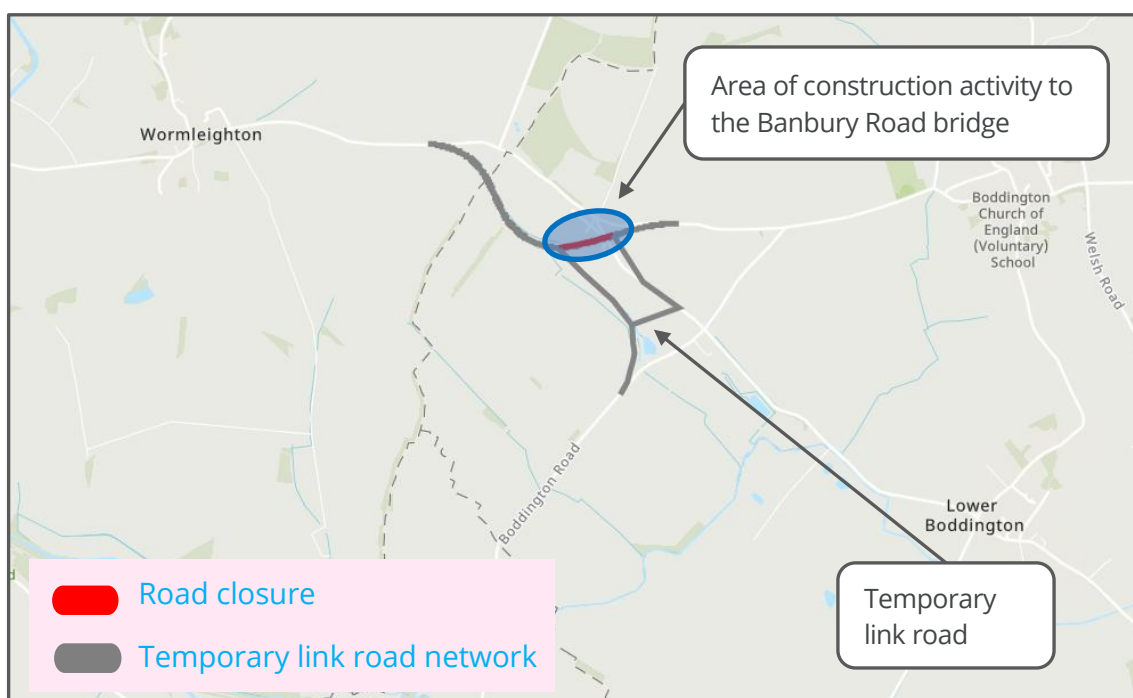
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Additional information:

During the summer, construction work will recommence on the Banbury Road bridge. Following the identification of steelwork welding defects during previous inspections, additional assessments and planning have been undertaken to ensure the bridge can be completed safely and to the required standards. Activities will take place both beneath the bridge and on the bridge itself. This work will involve the use of heavy machinery and a crane, which may generate some additional construction noise. Some parapets may need to be temporarily removed to allow access to the steelwork; these will be reinstated once the works are completed later this year. The remedial works will involve repairs and strengthening to sections of the steelwork where welding defects were identified. These works are localised in nature and do not require the demolition or replacement of significant elements of the bridge structure. Once the steelwork has been fully inspected and the necessary remedial works completed, the road will be resurfaced and prepared for opening.
