

Notice of road closure and traffic lights, A423, Southam

HS2-EKFB-26-2275

Location

A423, Banbury Road, near Southam.

Duration

Lane closures with traffic lights: Monday 10 August to Friday 21 August, 7pm to 7am.

Full road closure: Friday 21 August to Wednesday 2 September 2026, 24 hours a day.

Lane closure with traffic lights: Wednesday 2 September to Wednesday 30 September, 24 hours a day.

What we are doing

Construction activities to join the new road bridge over the HS2 railway line into the existing road.

What to expect

- Before and after the road closure, traffic lights will be in place to complete works at the roadside under a lane closure.
- The road closure commencing on Friday 21 August will be continuous, with no access for all road users.
- Access will be maintained for properties within the closure area and for staff to access the EKFB compound only.
- Some 24-hour working and weekend working will be required.
- Following the closure, the existing traffic-light controlled access to the EKFB compound will remain in place.

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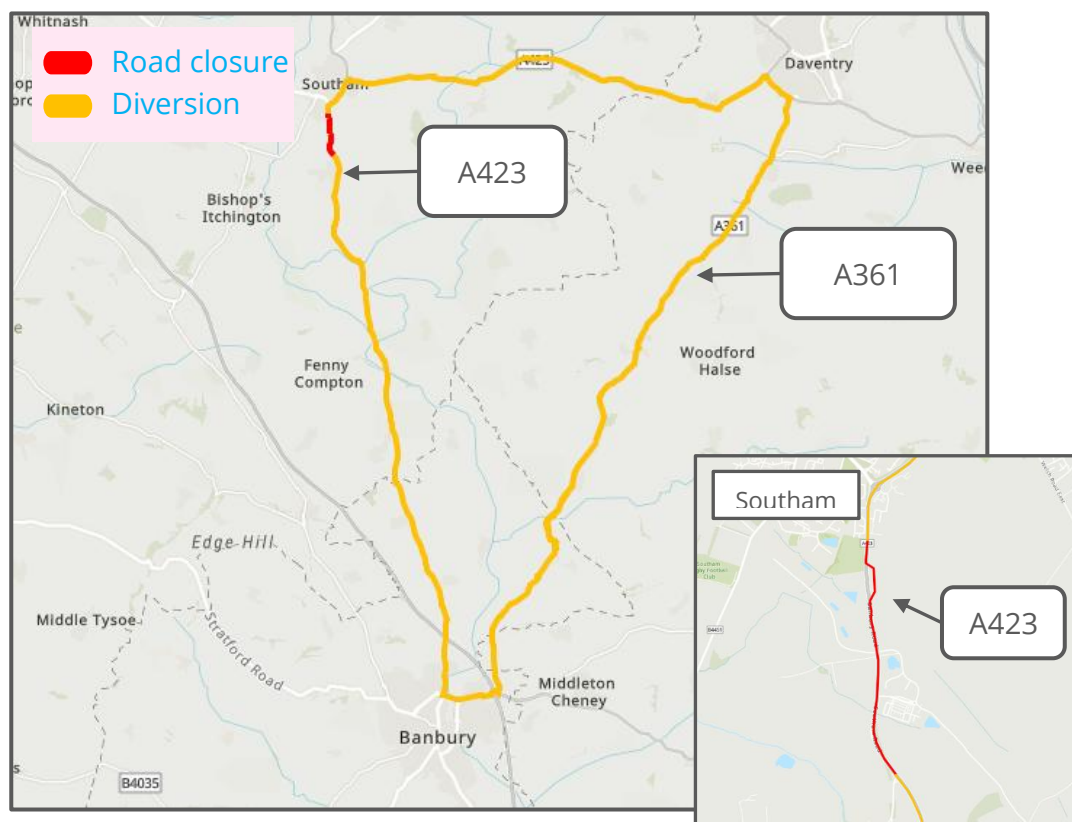
Additional information and diversion map

Ahead of the road closure, there will be approximately a week of overnight traffic-light controlled lane closures within the area of the road closure to complete essential works. The road will then close for two weeks to complete road realignment work. The new road layout over the bridge on the A423 will be opened to traffic once this road closure has been lifted.

Following the road closure, temporary traffic lights for a lane closure will be in place for approximately 4 weeks, while we complete utility connections and further construction work. The shared use footpath will open at a later date once its construction has been completed.

Please follow the signed diversion route for all traffic, as shown on the map below. Please allow additional time and plan your journey, taking care when traveling on unfamiliar routes.

Please note that there is a 7.5-tonne weight restriction over the railway bridge at Deppers Bridge, along the B4451. Additional restrictions apply through Ladbroke and on Ladbroke Road from Bishops Itchington, please check your route before you travel. These villages are not along our signed diversion route.



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
