

Update: Notice of road closure and traffic lights, Claydon Road, Upper Boddington

Location

The section of Claydon Road past Spella House, Upper Boddington.

Duration

Full road closure: Monday 10 August to Monday 14 September 2026, 24 hours a day

Lane closure with traffic lights at the junction of Warwick Road and Banbury Road: Monday 24 August to Friday 28 August, daytime.

Updated Wednesday 5 August

What we are doing

Working with West Northamptonshire Council, we will be installing two passing bays and resurfacing the road.

What to expect

Workforce and machinery in the road. Access will be maintained to Spella House from Banbury Road.

The road will remain as a one-way system until the Banbury Road bridge is open. This is expected to be by Autumn 2027.

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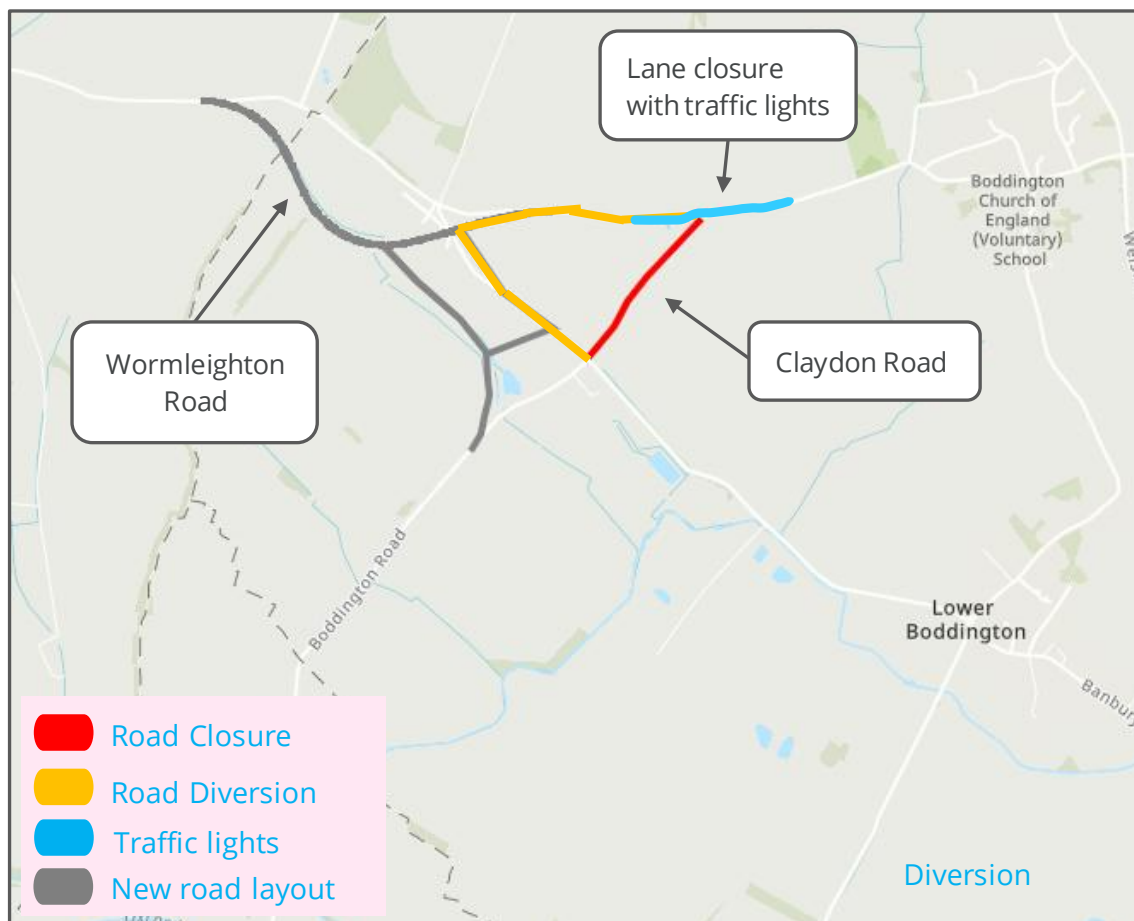
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Where we will be working:
