We will be working between 8.00am and 4.00pm, with no noisy works before 9.00am.

What we are doing

We are removing a tree which is along the route of a power cable. This was originally planned to form part of the tree-felling work, which was carried out in March 2026, but the potential for nesting birds was discovered and work was postponed.

The power cable will play an essential role in powering the wider area as well as Old Oak Common station. Due to access limitations, the cable cannot be installed without the removal of this tree. An ecologist has since re-inspected and approved the work.

What to expect

We will use small chainsaws to cut the tree down in sections. The work is being carried out on a Sunday during a scheduled closure for a wider set of railway works. We will monitor noise to make sure it does not exceed acceptable levels, and we will brief our teams on the importance of working quietly.

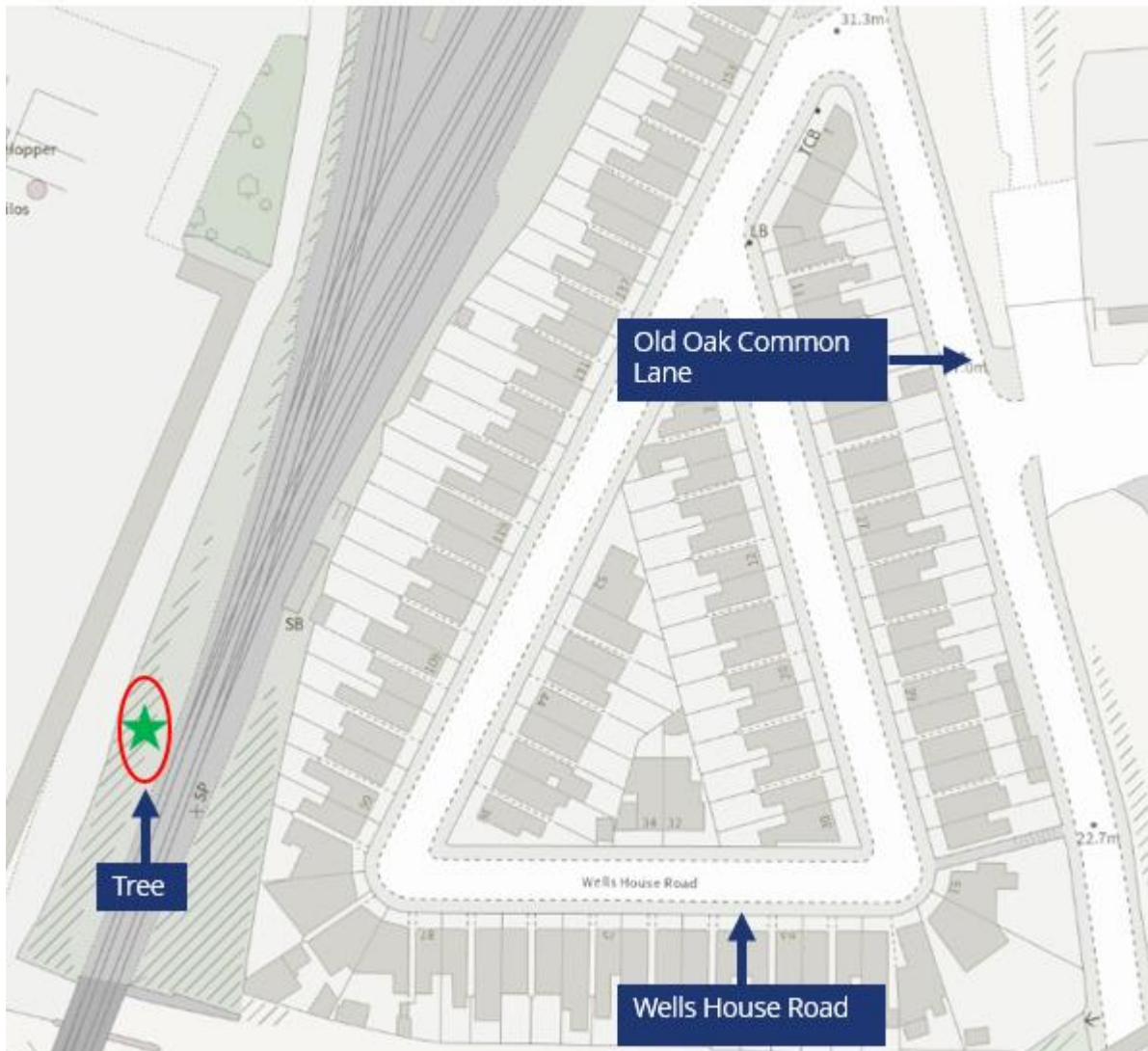
