From Monday 7 September to Friday 25 September 2026, temporary traffic lights will be in place on the A429 Kenilworth Road. They will operate from 7:00 pm till 5:30 am each night.

What we are doing

We will be removing the plant crossing and completing the footpath.

Phase 1: Monday 7 to Friday 11 September footpath works

Phase 2: Monday 14 to Friday 25 September, plant crossing removal

We will be working overnight on the weekend of the 19 and 20 September

What to expect

Two-way temporary traffic lights. Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained. Please see the map on page two for the location of the traffic lights.

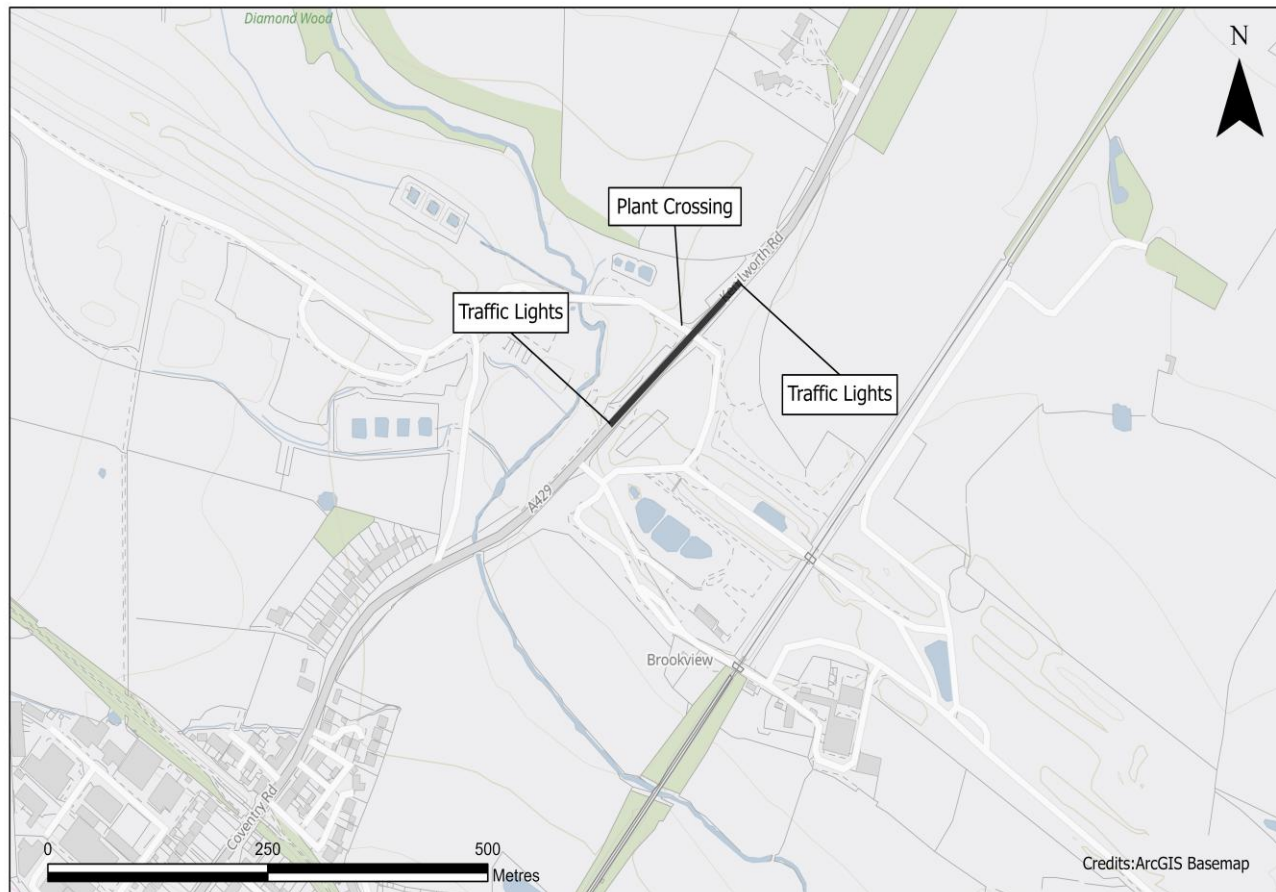
