Reinstatement of paving in loading bay

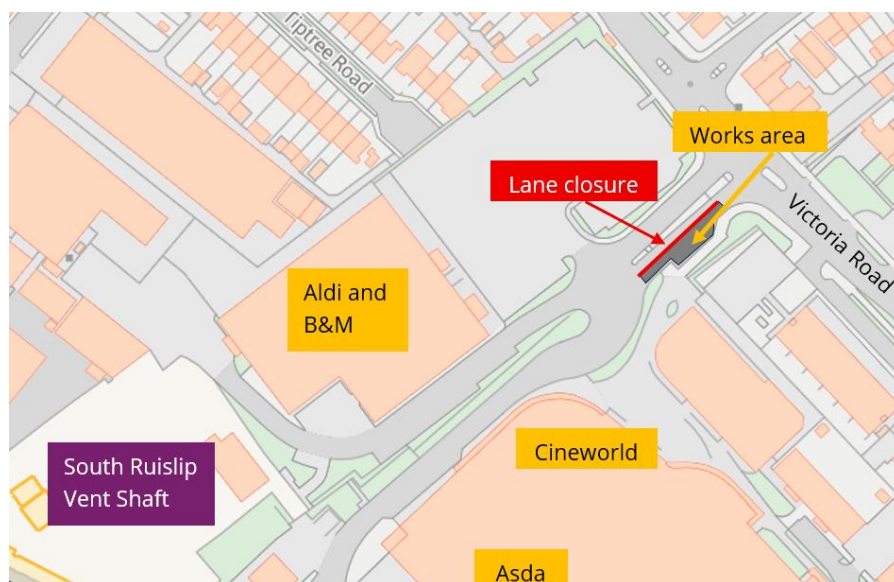
We will reinstate the original block paving in the loading bay at The Old Dairy, Victoria Road, South Ruislip. The paving was removed for UKPN works earlier this year.

A lane closure will be in place during these works. Access for deliveries to local businesses will be maintained throughout.

You may notice some noise from construction equipment, including an excavator, road saw and handheld tools, which will be used to remove the existing surface and prepare the area. A new concrete base will then be installed before the original paving blocks are reinstated by hand.
