We will be implementing a single lane closure of the A412, North Orbital Road which will be managed by three-way traffic signals.

What to expect

The traffic management will be installed at 7pm on 18 September and will remain in place for the duration of the works to enable the safe completion of the tie-in and resurfacing activities at Tilehouse Lane.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption, however road users may experience delays while the works are underway. Appropriate signage and traffic management measures will be in place throughout the duration of the works.
