Canterbury Works Ventilation Shaft and Headhouse site, Canterbury Road, South Kilburn

Duration

24 September 2026 to 15 February 2027.
These works will take place from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

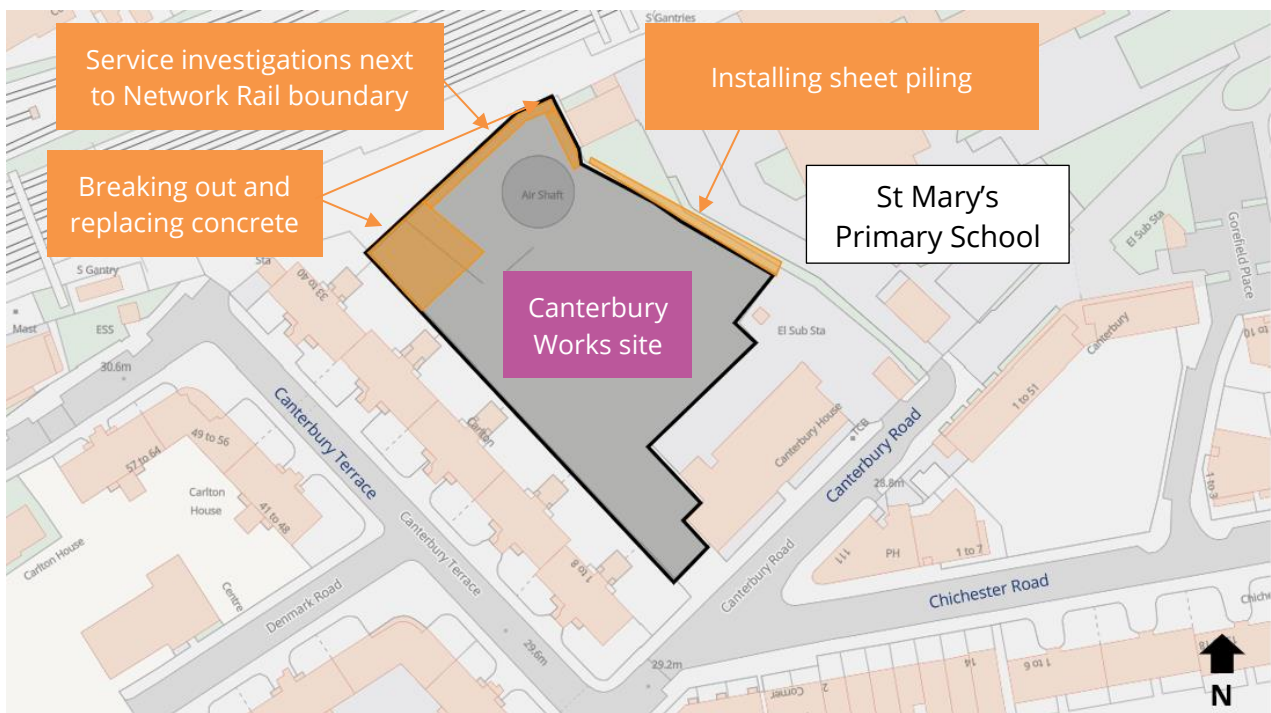

Works	Time period
Service investigations next to Network Rail boundary	24 September to 30 September 2026
Breaking out and replacing concrete and relocating hoarding	28 September to 8 October 2026
Sheet piling work along the boundary shared with St Mary's Primary School	5 October to 13 October 2026
Remove stormwater and foul drainage systems	13 to 22 October 2026
Sheet piling work along the northern boundary	19 October to 11 November 2026
Remove high-voltage services and building a new high-voltage service pit	From 23 October 2026
Install reinforcement and pouring concrete walls and foundations	17 November 2026 to 15 February 2027

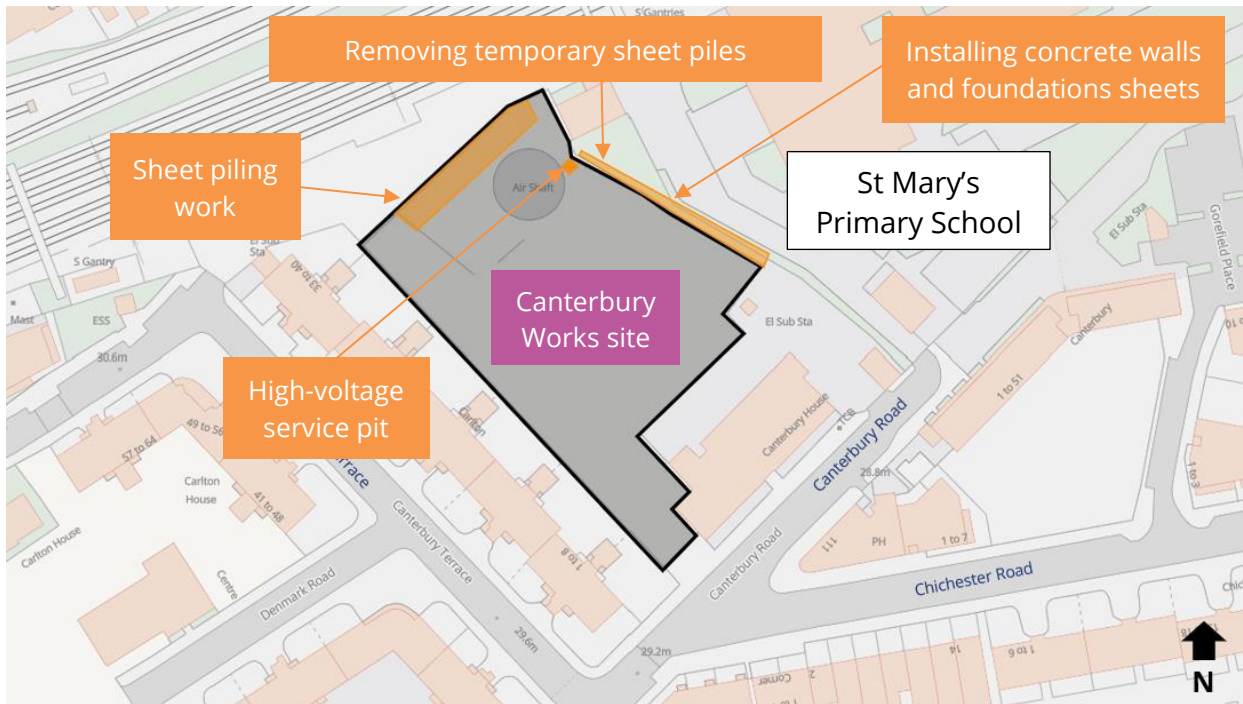

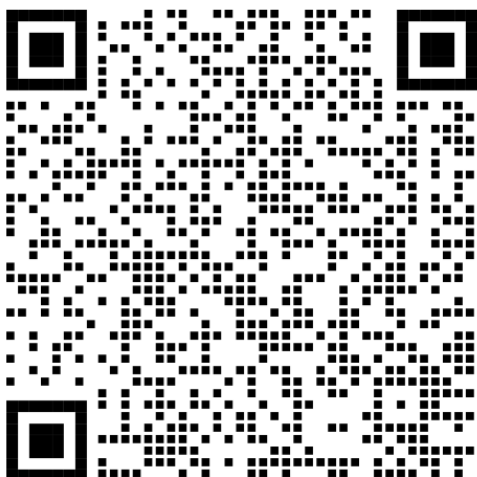

About our Community and Business Funds
