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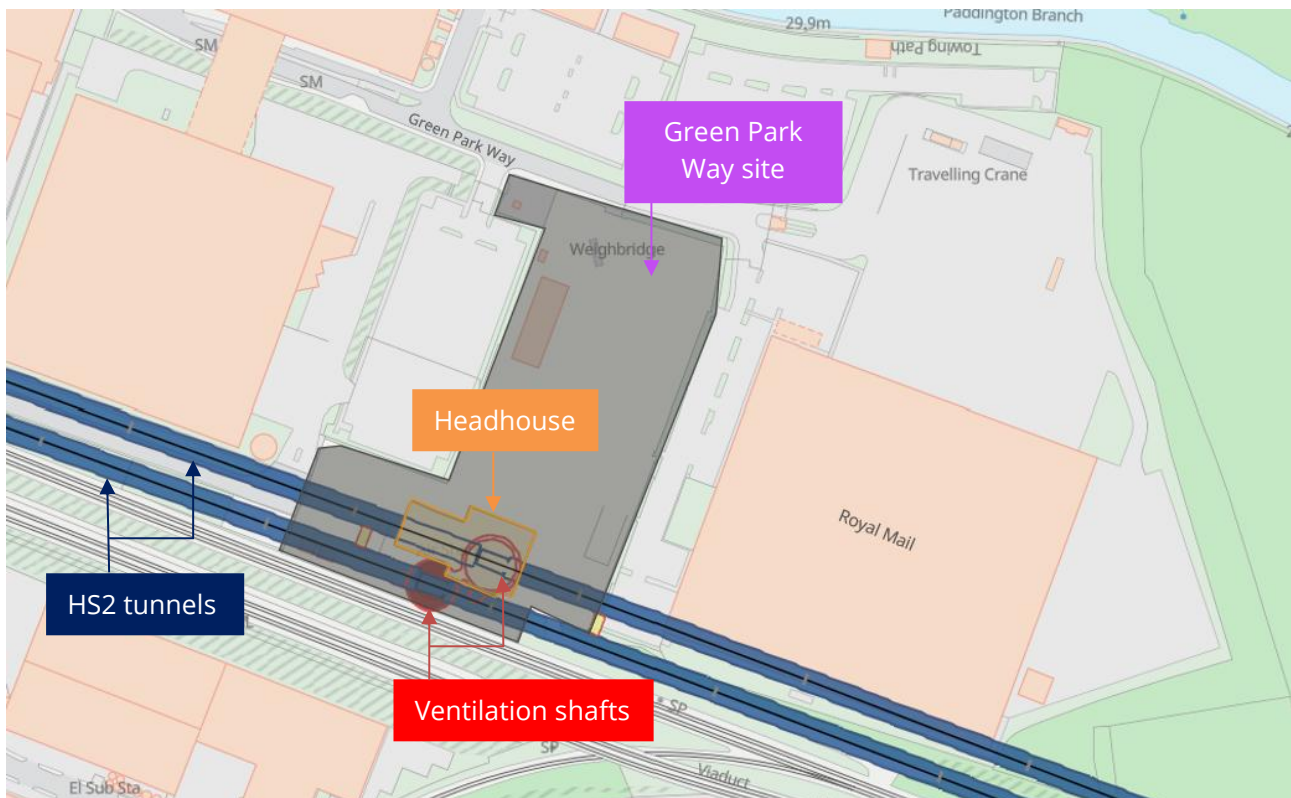
Additional information:

We will work underground to install concrete collars where the ventilation shafts meet the tunnels. Within the shafts, we'll continue waterproofing works and build concrete walls and platforms.

At ground level, we'll start to build the concrete and steel structure of the headhouse, the building that sits on top of the shaft. We will also continue drainage and utility maintenance works.

Our works are ongoing below and above ground. The locations of the ventilation shafts and headhouse are shown on the map below.
