What we are doing

Construction activities to join the new road bridge over the HS2 railway line into the existing road.

What to expect

- The road closure commencing on Monday 12 October will be continuous, with managed access to the Rugby Club.
- Traffic lights on the roundabout at Lark Road junction.
- Some 24-hour working and weekend working will be required. There may be some additional lighting and noise.
- Following the closure, the new road alignment will be in operation, with associated road sign changes.

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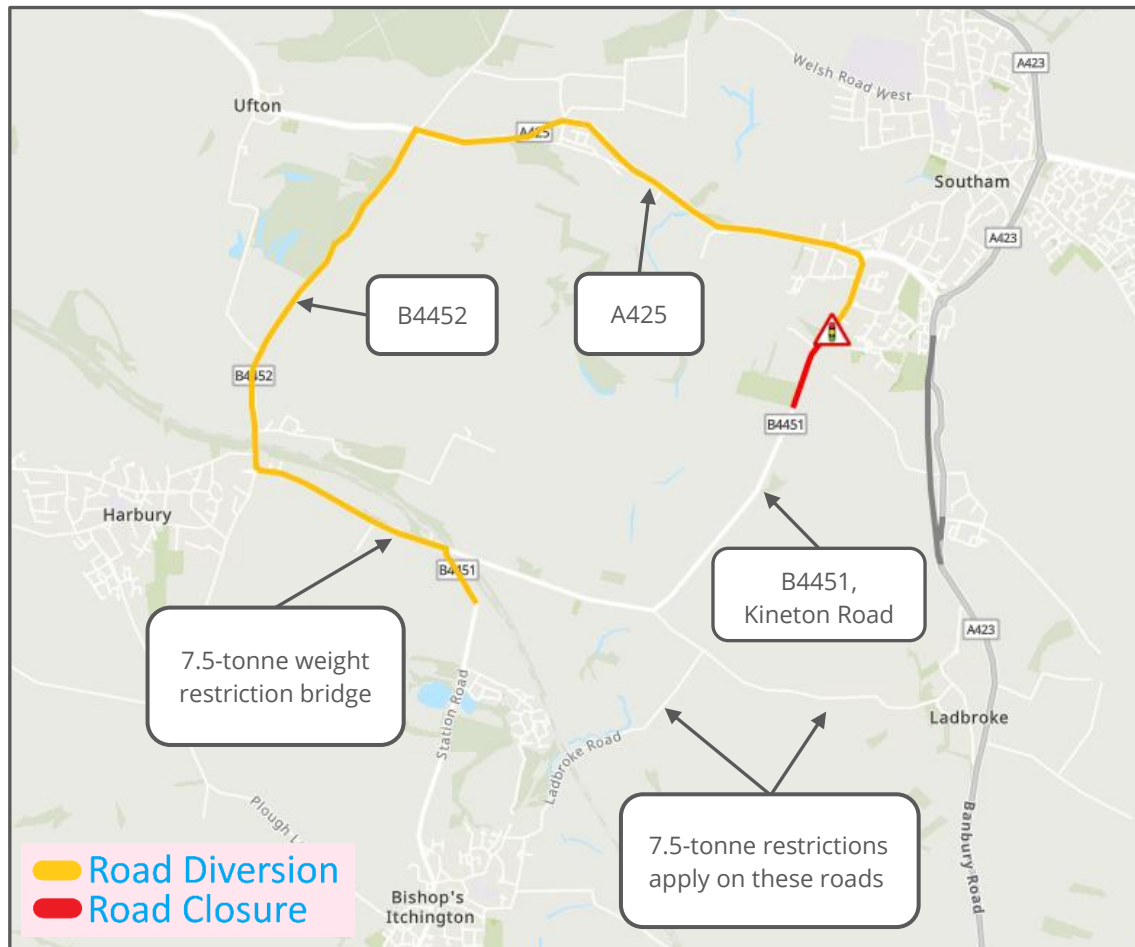
Additional information

The new bridge will be open to traffic following the four-week road closure. The bridge has a standard 6-metre-wide carriageway, for two-way traffic and a 1.5metre footpath over the line of the new railway.

Diversion route

Please follow the signed diversion route for all traffic, as shown on the map below. Please allow additional time and plan your journey, taking care when travelling on unfamiliar routes.

Please note that there is a 7.5-tonne weight restriction over the railway bridge at Deppers Bridge, along the B4451. Additional restrictions apply through Ladbroke and on Ladbroke Road from Bishops Itchington, please check your route before you travel. These villages are not along our signed diversion route.
