What we are doing

Installation of the fourth
of four large tower cranes on site.

What to expect

We will put the tower crane together on site using a mobile crane. HGVs will deliver the components of the crane during normal working hours and on Sunday (8am – 6pm). They will arrive on site on Friday, and we will assemble over the weekend. Once we complete the assembly of the tower crane, we will dismantle and remove the mobile crane from site.

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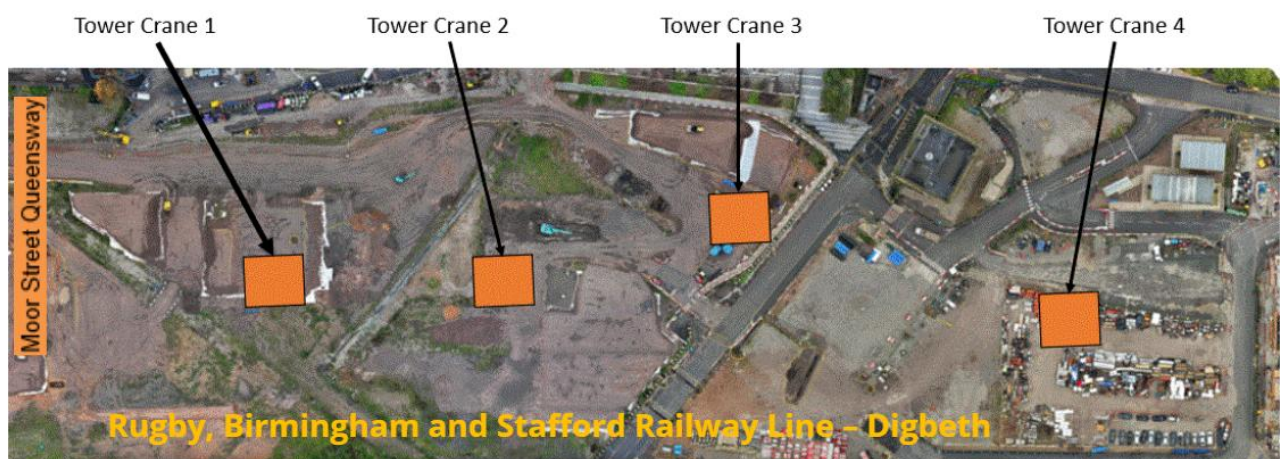
Additional information

For safety reasons, we can only install the tower cranes during good weather. If weather conditions are not suitable, this will impact on the installation dates. The final tower crane will be delivered and assembled later in October. You may see our operatives walking on the cranes while they are being assembled. Once the tower cranes are in place, they will be operational during normal core working hours.

We recognise that construction work can be disruptive to those living or working nearby. The nature of our work often means some disturbance is unavoidable. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary noise. We will closely monitor all noise, vibration, and dust levels to ensure we do not exceed our agreed limits.
