What we are doing

We'll strengthen the gas main beneath Parkway ahead of the tunnelling works.

We'll divert the gas main to accommodate the future tunnelling works.

Changes to Parkway junctions will begin in September ahead of the main gas works to reduce impact on local traffic.

What to expect

Periods of increased noise.

Monitoring our works to ensure we are within approved noise limits.

Lane and road closures with diversions in place.

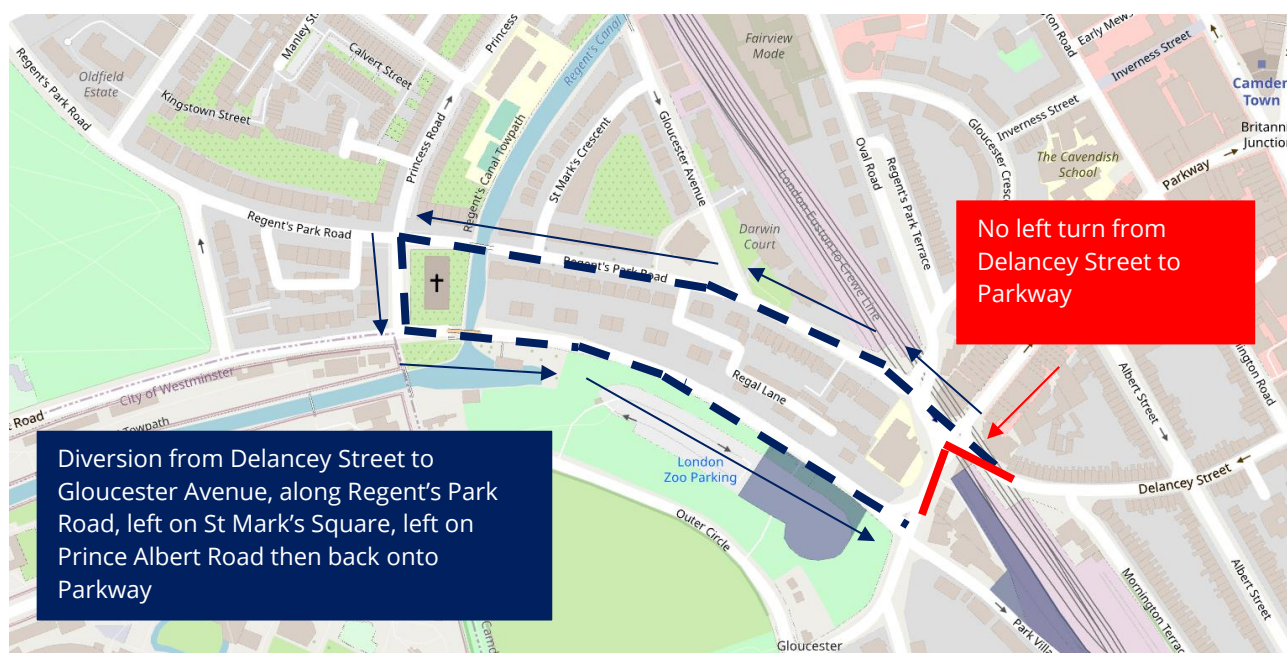
Parkway – Gas mitigation works

We will strengthen and protect the Gas main beneath Parkway junction before the arrival of the tunnel boring machine (TBM). To help protect the gas network, we will replace sections of the existing gas main with a new main before tunnelling arrives at Euston. Please note your gas supply will not be affected.

From **2 November 2026** to early **March 2027**, we will close several lanes on Delancey Street and Parkway.

Vehicles will not be able to turn left from Delancey Street onto Parkway. The diversion will follow from Delancey Street across Gloucester Avenue, along Regent's Park Road, left on St Mark's Square, left on Prince Albert Road, then back via Parkway. See map below.

We will install temporary lights and temporary pedestrian crossings around the junction.



Junction changes prior to Gas mitigation works

Prior to starting the gas mitigation work, we will make changes to the junctions around Parkway to reduce the impact on traffic during the gas mitigation works. The work will begin in September. The island removal works will start on 28 September, and will be completed by 30 October, with the gas mitigation works starting on **2 November** until **March 2027**.

Where we will be working

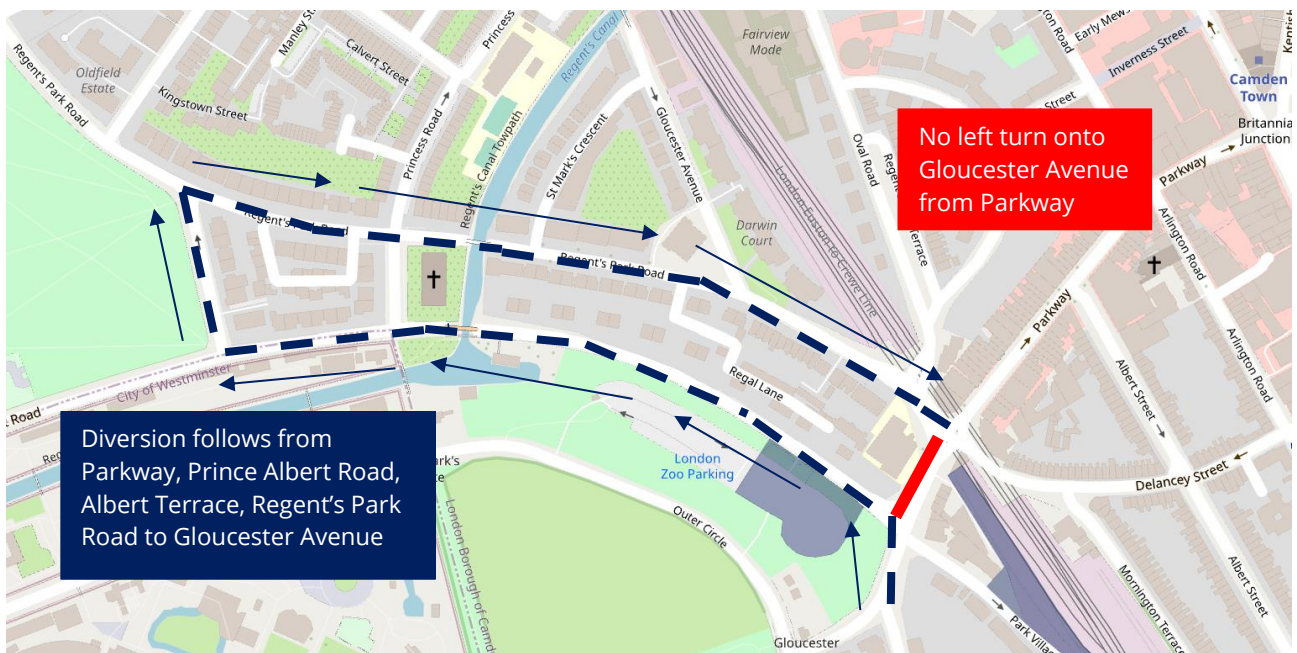
We will be working at the junction between Parkway, Gloucester Avenue, and Delancey Street. Different roads will be affected during different phases. Weekend work will be required, please see the specific weekend the dates below:

- 3 October 26 – Excavation, reinstatement, and surfacing
- 10 October 26 – Excavation, reinstatement, and surfacing
- 17 October 26 – Excavation, reinstatement, and surfacing
- 24 October 26 – Excavation, reinstatement, and surfacing

Weekend working hours will be from 8am – 6pm. Any noisy or breaking works will be completed by 1pm.

Phase 1 Traffic Island Removal

On **28 September**, we'll begin removing the islands from Parkway. There will be a lane closure on Parkway, preventing vehicles from turning left on Gloucester Avenue. Traffic will be diverted from Parkway to Prince Albert Road, Albert Terrace, Regent's Park Road, back onto Gloucester Avenue. We expect to complete this phase by **5 October**

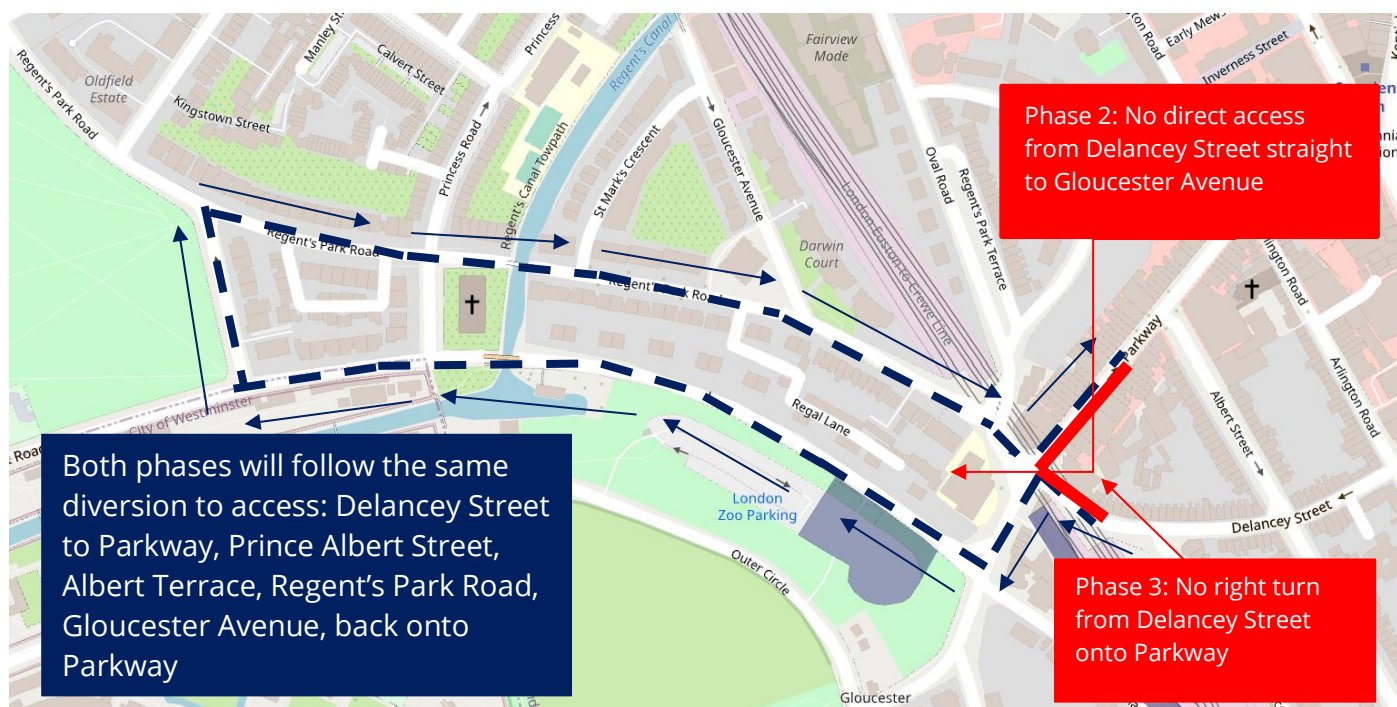


Phase 2 Traffic Island Removal

Traffic island removal works will continue **6 October**. There will be no direct access from Delancey Street into Gloucester Avenue across Parkway. This diversion will follow from Delancey Street onto Parkway, Prince Albert Road, Albert Terrace, Regent's Park Road to Gloucester Avenue. We expect to complete this phase by **14 October**.

Phase 3 Traffic Island Removal

The third phase of the traffic island removal will start on **15 October**. Vehicles will be banned from turning right from Delancey Street onto Parkway. You are also unable to go straight from Delancey Street to Gloucester Avenue. These diversions will mirror phase 2 diversions starting with a left turn from Delancey Street to Parkway, Prince Albert Street, Albert Terrace, Regent's Park Road, Gloucester Avenue back onto Parkway. We expect to complete this phase by **30 October**.
